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OVERVIEW

The Bali 4.6 from Bali Catamarans represents a modern sail catamaran option within the catamaran market, constructed on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic foundation. Measuring 46 ft (14.28 m) overall with a generous 25 ft (7.66 m) beam, it offers a considered blend of interior volume, steadiness underway, and dependable performance for comfortable cruising with family, friends, or crew.

Selecting a Bali 4.6

Opting for the Bali 4.6 means favoring efficient passage-making, expansive onboard living, and user-friendly handling typical of a sail catamaran in the catamaran category. Its shallow 4.003 ft (1.22 m) draft widens the range of accessible anchorages, while twin inboard diesel powerplants add redundancy and cruising range. With four heads and a dedicated crew berth, it is well configured for extended stays aboard.

- Dual inboard Yanmar diesel engines (2) delivering dependable propulsion and easy maneuvering.
- Cruising speed of 9 kn (10.36 mph) and a top speed of 12 kn (13.81 mph) for economical passages.
- Shallow 4.003 ft (1.22 m) draft to reach more marinas and secluded anchorages.

- Broad 25 ft (7.66 m) beam for enhanced stability and onboard space.
- Four heads and one crew bed to accommodate a variety of cruising configurations.
- Hull constructed to the fiberglass and plastic standard; fiberglass deck for longevity and reduced upkeep.
- Balanced tankage of 211.34 gal water and 211.34 gal fuel to support extended autonomy.

Q: Is the Bali 4.6 considered a sail catamaran? A: Yes. It is categorized as a sail yacht within the catamaran class, marrying multihull steadiness with sailing efficiency.

Q: What are the **cruising speed** and **maximum speed** of the Bali 4.6? A: The boat's **cruising speed** is 9 kn (10.36 mph) and its **maximum speed** is 12 kn (13.81 mph).

Q: How shallow can the Bali 4.6 go, and why does **draft** matter? A: With a **draft** of 4.003 ft (1.22 m), it can access shoal anchorages and marinas that are off-limits to deeper-keeled craft.

Q: What **engines** power the Bali 4.6? A: It is fitted with 2 inboard **Yanmar diesel** engines, providing redundancy and dependable propulsion.

Q: What are the hull and deck **materials** ? A: The hull is built to the fiberglass and plastic standard, and the deck is **fiberglass** , chosen for durability and easier maintenance.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the Bali 4.6 from Bali Catamarans for its sociable, family-oriented cruising design. The forward cockpit, raised flybridge and open-plan saloon—linked by the expansive tilting aft “Bali Door”—deliver a seamless indoor/outdoor lifestyle that reviewers and charter clients frequently applaud. Versatile interior arrangements (3, 4 or 5 cabins, with an

owner's-suite variant) and a galley equipped with a full-size fridge/freezer make it attractive for charter operations and liveaboard crews seeking increased volume and storage; owners also reference specifications approximating 800 L of combined fuel/water capacity.

On the water, testers say the yacht performs particularly well on a reach. Sea trials logged about 5 knots in 10–12 knots of wind when sailing, while at least one owner reported averaging well over 8 knots VMG upwind in 15 knots true. Under power, reported speeds are roughly 6 knots at 2000 rpm and about 8 knots at 2500 rpm. The design prioritizes accommodation rather than racing performance—one expert even called it a vessel for “pampered crew”—yet it can still make respectable passages in moderate conditions.

There are trade-offs and maintenance items to consider. One owner characterized the design as heavily oriented toward bay cruising and not ideal for rough offshore weather, and some owners report uncomfortable motion in choppy seas. Several users point out attention is needed for door sealing: the forward door can admit water under pressure, and the large tilt-up doors require routine checks. Prospective buyers also highlight practical concerns like windlass motor access beneath the foredeck, steering that can feel stiff and less precise at low speeds, and many advise opting for the 57 hp engine package rather than the base 40 hp for more demanding offshore use.

Pros and Cons

- Very generous indoor/outdoor living areas thanks to the forward cockpit and expansive tilting aft door, widely praised by owners and reviewers.
- Adaptable 3–5 cabin layouts, including an owner's-suite option, well suited to family cruising, liveaboard lifestyles and charter operations.
- Performs especially well on a reach and can achieve strong VMG in moderate winds, according to tests and owner feedback.

- Design favors calm-water and bay cruising; several owners report uneasy motion in chop and heavier seas.
- Forward door and large tilt-up door seals may leak under pressure and need periodic inspection and maintenance.
- Steering can feel tight and less precise at lower speeds; many recommend upgrading to the 57 hp engines over the standard 40 hp for offshore capability.
