## OVERVIEW

---

The 4.5 from BALI is a sail yacht configured as a catamaran, built using fiberglass and plastic and driven by a pair of Volvo Penta Sail Drive diesel engines. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Selecting a 4.5

---

If you want a yacht that balances overall length with living and deck volume, the 4.5 pairs a 44 ft (13.6 m) LOA with a wide 24 ft (7.42 m) beam and a shallow 4.003 ft (1.22 m) draft. Twin Volvo Penta Sail Drive powerplants provide both easier handling and redundancy, while the catamaran hull form delivers enhanced stability and onboard comfort. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: Which class of vessel is the 4.5 from BALI? A: It's a sail yacht laid out as a catamaran with a hull constructed from fiberglass and plastic. The **type** and **configuration** make it suitable for a wide range of sailing uses.

Q: What is the propulsion for this model? A: This yacht is fitted with **two** Volvo Penta engines using **Sail Drive** units and running on **diesel**, providing dependable power and straightforward handling.

Q: Can you summarize the principal dimensions? A: The vessel's **LOA** measures 44 ft (13.6 m), the **beam** is 24 ft (7.42 m), and the maximum **draft** is 4.003 ft

(1.22 m).

Q: What capacities does it carry for cruising? A: Onboard storage includes a **water capacity** of 211.34 gal and a **fuel capacity** of 211.34 gal, allowing longer intervals between resupply.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and charter operators often select the 4.5 from BALI for bareboat charters across the Caribbean and Mediterranean, as well as for family-oriented tropical cruising. The yacht's open-plan layout—with a solid foredeck featuring a forward lounge, a large vertical drop-down salon window, and plentiful seating—proves extremely effective for anchoring in social settings and weekend gatherings. Reports indicate the salon remains comfortable with six to eight people aboard; the full-size refrigerator with icemaker supports extended onboard living, and the 3-cabin owner's arrangement delivers a generously sized shower, a desk, and ample storage—while the 4-cabin charter layouts understandably feel more confined within the hulls.

Underway, professional evaluations characterize the 4.5 as a relaxed cruiser that readily surfs waves; its higher-than-average bridgedeck clearance helps reduce pounding and keeps the motion quiet. Trialed motoring figures were about 8.0 knots at 2,100 rpm and around 9.5 knots at full throttle on fixed-pitch props, with folding propellers offered as an option to reduce drag. One delivery log noted a persistent need for rudder input to achieve ideal helm balance. Comments on maintenance skew toward charter-fleet issues: multiple charter reviews list equipment failures—generators cutting out,

air-conditioning problems, fridge breakdowns, leaking toilets, and broken sliding-door stoppers—while technical observers point out that wiring, plumbing and systems are generally accessible, and many faults were traced to inconsistent upkeep rather than inherent design defects.

## Pros and Cons

- The open-plan configuration with a drop-down forward window and solid foredeck lounge is ideal for social anchoring and daytime use.
- The salon maintains a roomy feel with 6–8 occupants, and the full-size refrigerator with icemaker is well suited to family and tropical cruising.
- Sea trials report easy wave-surfing, enhanced bridgedeck clearance and a quiet onboard ride, with systems that are relatively simple to access for maintenance.
- Charter operators have reported repeated equipment issues (generator cut-outs, nonfunctional AC, failing refrigerators, leaking heads, and broken sliding-door stoppers).
- One owner’s delivery report mentioned the helm never achieving perfect balance, requiring some constant rudder angle.
- The yacht’s personality leans toward relaxed cruising rather than high-performance racing.
