OVERVIEW

The BALI 4.6 OPEN SPACE 3 CABIN OWNERS VERSION from BALI is a modern sail catamaran that emphasizes a generous, open-plan interior and robust construction using a fiberglass and plastic hull. Marketed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this design integrates practical twin-diesel propulsion with comfortable living quarters for cruising owners.

Selecting a BALI 4.6 OPEN SPACE 3 CABIN OWNERS VERSION

If your priorities include expansive indoor/outdoor living, an owner-centric three-cabin arrangement, and the ability to cruise in shallow waters, the BALI 4.6 OPEN SPACE 3 CABIN OWNERS VERSION presents a strong option. At 47 ft (14.36 m) LOA with a 25 ft (7.66 m) beam it offers substantial interior volume, and the 1.22 m (4.003 ft) draft increases anchoring flexibility. Twin inboard Yanmar diesels provide dependable handling—well suited to private ownership, skippered cruising, or operations supported by dedicated crew accommodation.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is this model? A: It is a sail yacht catamaran featuring a **three-cabin owner's layout** and built with a **fiberglass and plastic hull** .

Q: Who designed the yacht? A: The exterior hull form was crafted by **Olivier Poncin**, while the interior package was developed by **Lasta Design Studio**, pairing seakeeping considerations with liveboard comfort.

Q: What are the engine details? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 Yanmar Inboard Diesel** engines, selected for dependable power delivery and straightforward maintenance access.

Q: What are the main capacities for longer stays? A: Fuel and potable water tanks each hold **211.34 gal**, supporting extended periods away from port.

Q: Is there dedicated space for crew? A: Yes—there are **2 crew cabins** with **2 beds**, offering flexible accommodation for crew or additional guests. For specific guidance contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the BALI 4.6 OPEN SPACE 3 CABIN OWNERS VERSION from BALI for its signature Open Space philosophy: the hydraulically tilting, garage style aft door effectively merges the cockpit, saloon, and forward lounge into one continuous living area, delivering almost 360° sightlines and an unusually voluminous interior. In the three cabin Owner's Version, an entire hull is devoted to a private master suite with an en suite bathroom, lounge seating, and significant locker space—attributes owners appreciate for long-term cruising or liveboard use. The same configuration works well in private charters, while the large saloon, well appointed galley, forward cockpit and sunpads create a social platform ideal for entertaining family and friends.

When sailing, the general expectation is comfort rather than speed. Owners and sea trials commonly report speeds around 5 knots in 10–12 knots of true wind, with higher numbers on a beam reach and reduced performance upwind in light airs. The platform feels stable and roomy underway, though the

combination of a solid foredeck and the Open Space fitout increases windage and weight forward, which can blunt performance in light conditions. Maneuvering in tight spaces may feel less responsive, with some owners noting steering that can be tight or imprecise at low speeds.

Regarding upkeep, surveyors and owners highlight the need to inspect the windlass motor access beneath the foredeck, check foredeck drainage, and account for the additional forward weight during condition surveys. Within the Bali range there are recurring accounts of windlass, air conditioning, generator, and bilge/sump problems—issues often tied to intensive charter use or deferred maintenance—so prospective buyers typically scrutinize the windlass, chain locker drainage, and engine room accessibility. As for serious offshore ambitions, owners remain divided on whether the BALI 4.6 OPEN SPACE 3 CABIN OWNERS VERSION is fully suited to prolonged ocean passagemaking, producing a range of opinions.

Pros and Cons

- The Open Space saloon and garage style aft door deliver a fluid indoor/outdoor living environment with expansive panoramic views.
- The 3 cabin Owner's hull provides a private master suite and abundant storage, appealing for liveaboard cruising.
- Large galley, saloon, forward cockpit and sunbathing areas make hosting and family activities effortless.
- Sailing prioritizes comfort, with modest speeds—around 5 knots in 10–12 knots of breeze and reduced performance going upwind.
- Low speed and tight space handling can feel sluggish, with some owners describing steering as tight and imprecise.
- Windlass access can be inconvenient and there are owner reports of windlass, AC, generator and sump issues, particularly on former charter vessels.
