Configured as a capable cruiser, it features a planing hull and a resilient fiberglass and plastic build. Its planing hull, twin Cummins inboard diesels and a quoted top speed of 38 knots make it well suited to active itineraries, while the practical layout and simple systems keep routine operation and maintenance straightforward. ## Questions and Answers

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Q: What type of yacht is the Daychaser 48? A: It is a motor yacht laid out as an upscale cruiser, intended for assured performance and comfortable day to overnight operations.

Q: What is the hull made of? A: The hull is constructed from fiberglass and plastic and the deck uses an Epoxy Composite to add stiffness and long term durability.

Q: How fast can it go and what powers it? A: The published top speed is **38 kn (43.73 mph)** , achieved with **2 x Cummins inboard diesel** engines providing dependable propulsion.

Q: Who designed the hull and interior? A: The hull design is by **Doug ZurnBarton & Gray** , while the interior concept is by **Zurn Yacht Design** , delivering a balance of seakeeping and onboard refinement.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners choose the Daychaser 48 from BARTON & GRAY YACHTWORKS largely for the purpose it was conceived: effortless family day cruising and sociable entertaining. The design creates four distinct social zones—the forward lounge, an elevated pilothouse with a bar/galley-up configuration, aft chaises and an expansive beach club—allowing guests to circulate easily. Below decks remain intentionally focused on daytime use, offering a daybed, a generous head with a full shower and a compact navigation/desk nook. The raised helm and galley-up layout simplify guest service and preserve excellent sightlines underway.

Underway, twin Cummins QSB6.7s (~550 hp) driving Hamilton waterjets provide the shallow-draft capability needed for beach drops and shoal exploration. While owners report trial speeds around 35–36 knots, emphasis from owners and captains is on a composed, dry ride and predictable manners

rather than outright top speed; handling impressions note sharp response in quick turns and secure control near 30 knots. A Seakeeper gyro and Zipwake trim system help suppress roll and stabilize the boat when afternoon chop increases.

Day-to-day ownership has been engineered for accessibility: an oversized engine-room hatch gives straightforward access to the Cummins engines and Racor filters, and BARTON & GRAY YACHTWORKS provides managed-owner support including preventative maintenance programs, concierge technicians and transport services. Keep in mind this is a relatively new model with many hulls operating in club fleets since 2022, so long-term independent ownership histories are still emerging; as with any waterjet craft, regular inspection of impellers and seals by specialists is recommended, and the QSB6.7 engines benefit from disciplined service intervals.

## Pros and Cons

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- Thoughtful social zoning and a galley-up pilothouse foster guest interaction and simplify onboard service.
- Seakeeper gyro, Zipwake trim control and a dry, smooth hull shape combine to make passages comfortable even in choppy conditions.
- Hamilton waterjets and well-considered boarding ergonomics enable easy, safe access to shallow anchorages and the beach club.
- The below-deck arrangement is optimized for daytime use—offering a daybed and a full head rather than extensive overnight cabins.
- As a newer design with many boats in club service since 2022, independent long-term ownership data remains limited.
- Waterjets require specialist maintenance of impellers and seals, and the Cummins QSB6.7 engines require adherence to routine service schedules.
