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OVERVIEW

Represented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, the Bavaria Vision 46 from Bavaria Yachts is offered as a classic sail yacht in the segment of cruising sailboats. Built in the fiberglass and plastic category with a fiberglass deck, this design is driven by a single Volvo Penta diesel engine.

Selecting a Bavaria Vision 46

Opting for the Bavaria Vision 46 reflects a desire for well-proportioned cruising accommodation combined with operational simplicity. At 45 ft LOA with a 13 ft beam, it strikes a balance between roomy living areas and manageable sailing characteristics. The 6.562 ft (2 m) max draft allows access to many harbors and anchorages. A single Volvo Penta diesel keeps systems straightforward to own and maintain, and a generous 134.73 gal fresh water tank supports longer time between resupplies. Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly employ the Bavaria Vision 46 from Bavaria Yachts for family voyages, weekend coastal hops, and moderate passages; many vessels also serve in charter fleets thanks to a roomy cockpit and folding transom. When sailing it is generally easy to handle, with reports of approximately 8 knots boat speed in about 12 knots of beam wind and a 7–8 knot cruising speed under power. Reviewers praise its seakeeping and stability for a production cruiser, noting it points well and tacks in roughly the 80°–90° range, and that the optional Dock Control joystick with retractable thrusters significantly eases close-quarters handling—though some owners have implemented retrofits or adjustments to that system.

Below decks the layout feels open and airy, aided by large coachroof windows and roughly 7 feet of headroom that contribute to a well-ventilated saloon. The island-style galley is praised for its storage capacity and drains that function on either tack, while in the cockpit a hi/lo table converts into a sunpad and the transom lowers to create an expansive swim platform. The principal layout compromise is the absence of a dedicated nav station, which is substituted by a sofa and a convertible chart area. On the maintenance side, owners have reported a factory modification to the joystick docking system, incidents of water ingress into an aluminum cockpit table leg causing motor failure,

transducer and NMEA troubleshooting, and occasions where a backwinding winch failed to release during automatic tacks; at least one owner recorded transom/cockpit distortion or cracking that required reinforcement by Bavaria Yachts engineers.

Pros and Cons

- Manageable handling with commendable seakeeping and stability; the yacht points cleanly and tacks near the 80°–90° range.
- Bright, generous interior (approximately 7 ft headroom) featuring a practical island galley and a cockpit that converts to a sunpad with a drop-down swim platform.
- Optional Dock Control with joystick and retractable thrusters simplifies tight-manoeuve situations, and some owners have successfully retrofitted improvements.
- The standard saloon does not include a dedicated navigation station, relying instead on a convertible chart area.
- Reports exist of the Dock Control system needing a factory update, and occasional issues with the backwinding winch not releasing during automatic tacks.
- Owner-reported maintenance items include water ingress into the cockpit table leg resulting in motor failure, transducer/NMEA faults, and an isolated case of transom/cockpit distortion that required strengthening.

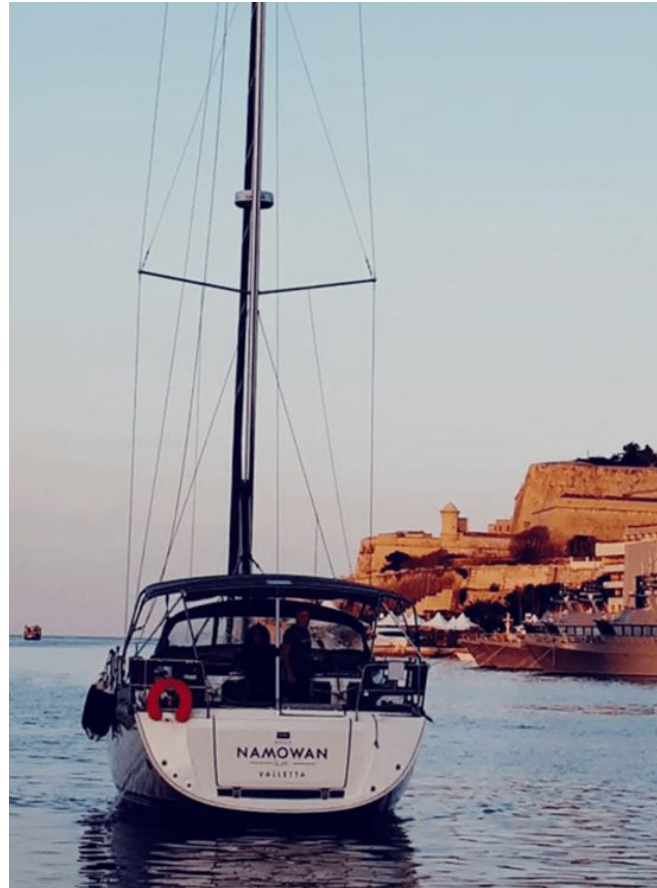

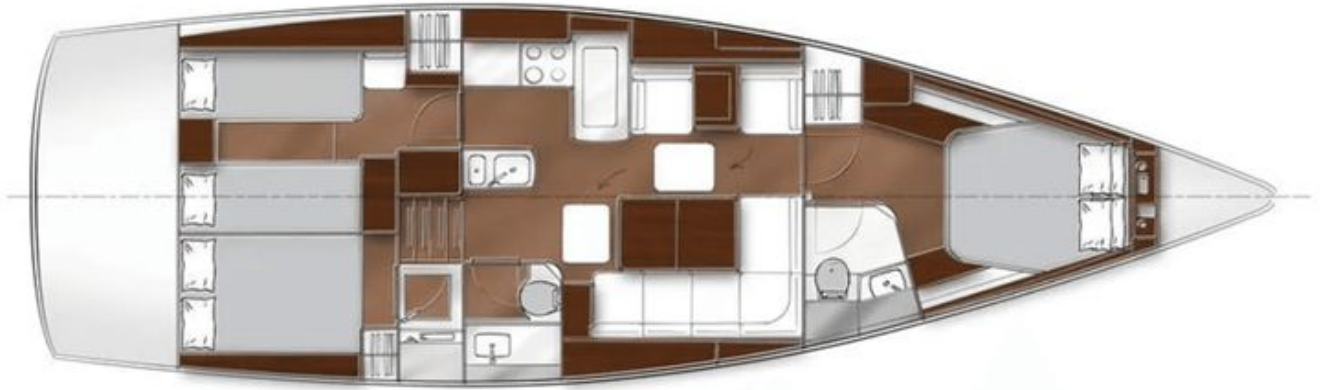
