Compact and adaptable, the Bayliner 285 from BAYLINER is a nimble motor yacht in the cruiser segment. Built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck, it measures 28 ft (8.53 m) overall with a 9 ft (3 m) beam and is driven by a single Mercruiser I/O gasoline engine — a sensible platform for coastal outings. Q: What type of yacht is the Bayliner 285? A: It's a compact motor yacht categorized as a cruiser, constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull designed for **durability** and **low maintenance** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically deploy the Bayliner 285 from BAYLINER as a family weekender and day cruiser on inland waters and sheltered coastal runs. The forward V-berth, dinette that converts to a berth, and aft cabin combine into a true six-berth arrangement, while the expansive swim platform and cockpit seating make loose socializing at anchor effortless; many owners fit camper canvas to lengthen usable season. Large side windows and deck hatches flood the cabin with light, producing an interior that many describe as surprisingly

airy for the boat's size.

Underway, performance tends to be practical rather than sporty. Owner reports and sea trials commonly show a cruise speed around 24 mph at 4000 rpm, with top-end figures close to 38 mph on the 350 MPI; numerous owners comment the boat is “not hot out of the hole” but finds adequate power once planing. Low-speed tracking and close-quarters handling are often praised compared with smaller models in the range, and several owners prefer the Bravo 3 drive for improved marina maneuverability.

Maintenance notes are typical for boats of this era. Engine-bay access receives positive mentions for ease of service, yet the absence of a dedicated access panel behind the helm means electronic work often requires removing dash panels. Common age-related concerns surface in owner forums—drooping headliners, canvas and upholstery deterioration, and vigilance for water intrusion that can lead to soft spots in the cabin sole or transom—so prospective buyers should plan a sea trial with typical load, inspect the outdrive carefully, and budget for routine impeller, anode, and lower-unit maintenance; minor cabin issues such as sticky door latches are also reported.

Pros and Cons

- Genuine six-berth weekend layout with V-berth, convertible dinette, and aft cabin.
- Bright, spacious interior with large windows, plus a generous cockpit and swim platform for entertaining.
- Predictable low-speed tracking and easier docking than smaller models, especially with a Bravo 3 drive.
- Hole-shot is modest, with power better expressed once the boat is on plane.
- Limited access behind the helm complicates electronics and wiring upgrades.
- Age-related issues to watch include sagging headliners, canvas wear, and

potential water intrusion causing soft spots in floors or the transom.
