Owner Experience Review

Owners and crews commonly use the Gran Turismo 45 by Beneteau for family outings and weekend day trips. The open hard-top, expansive sunpad and a sociable cockpit arrangement make short cruises and entertaining straightforward. Some boats are also marketed for charter, and listings sometimes show three-cabin variants. The hydraulic swim platform and onboard tender garage support light watersports, tender transfers and simple access to the water.

While underway, owners and reviewers report a comfortable cruise in the vicinity of 23–24 knots with top speeds in the low 30-knot range. The Air Step hull prioritizes stability over outright top-end velocity, and installations like Volvo Penta IPS with joystick steering and electronic throttles simplify docking and tight-maneuver situations. Sea trials note a “30-plus-knot” capability and relatively low noise levels — measurements near 72 dB in calm conditions — and accommodation spaces that are quieter than might be expected for a yacht of this length.

Below decks, the full-beam midships owner’s cabin with ensuite and separate shower earns compliments for its generous natural light and sense of space. The lower deck layout can favor an open saloon/dinette or be reconfigured to add berths, including an optional third cabin that trades open living areas for extra sleeping capacity. Finish quality is generally clean for a production yacht and includes practical features such as push-button galley latches, a pop-up TV and built-in chargers. Daily usability extends to the aft sunpad that lifts to reveal the tender garage and two service access routes via a swim-platform hatch and through the garage. That said, owner forums highlight variability across production boats and call attention to IPS pod maintenance concerns; comprehensive pre-purchase surveys and realistic budgeting for hydraulics, garage/winch systems and electronics are recommended to protect long-term

ownership value.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for family cruising, weekend entertaining, and even charter in three-cabin configurations.
- Stable, quiet ride with an easy 23–24-knot cruise and joystick-assisted close-quarters handling.
- Full-beam owner’s cabin plus a multifunction aft sunpad with tender garage boost comfort and fun.
- Owner and forum reports cite IPS pod water-ingress and seal failures that can bring costly repairs.
- As a production boat with complex hydraulics and electronics, it warrants a thorough survey and vigilant maintenance.
- Near-new depreciation can feel steep, according to market and forum sentiment.
