Owner Experience Review

Most owners find the GT 45 from Beneteau well-suited as a sociable dayboat that also functions as an accessible entry-level weekender. Its cockpit-focused arrangement makes entertaining straightforward, while couples and small families appreciate the accommodation for brief cruises. The model is also common in charter programs for day trips and longer hires in Mediterranean and Caribbean destinations, reflecting its broad usability and straightforward operation.

Sea trials indicate a time-to-plane around 8.8 seconds, a tested top speed approaching 37 mph, and an efficient cruise near 29.8 mph around 3200 RPM. The Air Step hull imparts confidence in beam seas; in head seas the most comfortable speeds are typically 25–27 mph to reduce hull slap. Low-speed maneuvering with Volvo Penta IPS and joystick control is precise for tight approaches and marinas, though higher-speed turns are naturally more expansive with IPS. Owners praise the open main deck with a large sunroof and sliding or folding glazing that creates excellent indoor–outdoor flow across the spacious U-shaped cockpit. Below deck the arrangement includes a full-beam aft owner cabin and a forward VIP with two heads standard, plus an optional third bunk cabin; the galley-down layout benefits from good natural light and approximately 6'7" of headroom. A dedicated tender garage and a

substantial hydraulic swim platform simplify storing and deploying toys and boarding, while features like the cockpit wet bar and electric TV enhance the yacht's entertainment credentials. Engine access via a large hatch in the tender garage and an additional port-side hatch is considered good for this class. As a relatively recent design, long-term failure patterns are not yet fully established; owners should adhere to scheduled Volvo Penta IPS maintenance and plan for pod servicing, recognizing that pod repairs have been expensive in some reported instances.

Pros and Cons

- Open main deck with large sunroof and sliding/folding glazing, plus a roomy U-shaped cockpit for hosting.
- Tender garage and large hydraulic swim platform simplify toy storage and water access.
- Air Step hull and IPS joystick provide a confident ride, precise docking, and a best cruise around 29.8 mph.
- High-speed turns are naturally wider with IPS.
- In head seas it performs best at about 25–27 mph to minimize hull slap.
- IPS pod servicing and potential repairs can be costly and require disciplined, scheduled maintenance.
