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OVERVIEW

Crafted by Benetti, the Cockpit measures 115 ft and presents as a luxury motor yacht in the Motor Yacht class. Its GRP-based construction uses a fiberglass and plastic platform with a semi-displacement hull form. Twin MTU inboard diesel engines propel the vessel, yielding a relaxed cruise of 12 kn (13.81 mph) and a top speed of 15 kn (17.26 mph), combining efficient performance with bluewater stability. with dependable cruising capabilities.

Owner Experience Review

Owners operating the Cockpit from Benetti commonly deploy her for multi-generation family cruising and for owner-operator passages, appreciating a ride that favors comfort over sporty responsiveness. Consistent with Benetti's approach, cruising typically sits in the low to mid teens, with handling characterized as composed rather than highly nimble, and the yacht maintains good seakeeping on extended passages.

In everyday use, the generous aft cockpit and beach club swim platform frequently become the primary gathering spaces—perfect for charter guest entertainment, staging watersports, or casual weekend socializing. Sliding glass doors often create an uninterrupted flow between salon and cockpit, while premium finishes, teak surfaces, and wide sightlines enhance the onboard

experience whether at anchor or underway.

Maintenance is viewed as realistic rather than minimal: owners and captains report more intricate systems and tighter service areas compared with some non Italian designs, summarized by one comment, "Pretty straight forward as far as build and such was concerned, however until you took the covers off, you found one mess after another." Teak decks require routine attention, and although engine room entry through aft or cockpit hatches and transom doors is convenient, some service areas can feel confined where tender garages or platform hardware reduce working space.

Pros and Cons

- Stable, comfort focused ride that suits long range family cruising.
- Large aft cockpit and beach club areas excel for charter and guest entertaining.
- Seamless indoor outdoor flow with high spec finishes and panoramic views.
- Systems and service spaces can be complex and tight compared with some rivals.
- Teak cockpit decks demand ongoing care, caulking, and cosmetic upkeep.
- Engine room access is often aft and can feel cramped where garages or platform gear intrude.
