Owner Experience Review

Owners typically describe the 22LSR by BENNINGTON as an ideal family weekend boat: suited to relaxed lake cruising, sandbar gatherings, evening runs, and frequent rental usage for casual entertaining. Many proprietors say they take it out nearly every weekend. It can tow tubes and support light watersports, though owners advise caution when towing at higher speeds.

Feedback on behavior underway varies but follows a consistent narrative. Some owners report a nervous, “might tip” sensation in larger wakes or during sudden high-speed turns, especially while towing. Others note steady performance when the engine trim is set correctly, running slightly bow-up and feeling stable with no perceptible deck flex even in chop. With a 150 hp outboard, owners and listings frequently report an economical cruise near 27 knots and top-end speeds in the mid-30s.

Aboard, multiple reviews and listings praise the generous seating, chaise lounge options, and an arrangement that supports socializing well. A common criticism targets the factory audio: passengers in the aft seating can have trouble hearing at cruise because some LSR layouts lack dedicated rear speakers. Maintenance and ownership chatter includes occasional squeaky power steering on newer examples, frequent recommendations to add a dual-battery system (commonly advised for improved reliability) plus a master power switch when ordering, and the need to obtain parts and accessories through dealers rather than a direct factory web portal. Routine engine work is typically performed by authorized Yamaha/Mercury service centers.

Pros and Cons

- Roomy seating and chaise-style lounges deliver a comfortable layout for groups.
- Reported cruise around 27 knots and mid-30s top speed with a 150 hp outboard.
- Feels solid underway when trimmed correctly, with owners noting no deck flex at speed.
- Some owners feel uneasy in large wakes and during abrupt turns at higher speeds, particularly when towing.
- Factory speaker placement can leave the aft seats with weak audio coverage on certain layouts.

- Occasional reports of squeaky power steering on newer boats.
