Opting for the 25 GL gives you a well-rounded platform that combines easy maneuverability with the open, social deck layout typical of a pontoon. At 25 feet overall, this motor yacht is tailored to owners who want uncomplicated handling and versatile day-cruising capabilities, while the aluminum hull delivers strength and minimal upkeep.

## Features of the Model

---

- Constructed by BENNINGTON, the 25 GL is built to prioritize solid craftsmanship and dependable on-water behavior.
- Single-engine configuration: one Yamaha outboard running on gasoline for straightforward operation and maintenance.
- Durable construction: an aluminum hull paired with an aluminum deck to extend service life.
- Right-sized footprint: 25 ft LOA and an 8 ft beam create a stable, social platform characteristic of a pontoon.
- Day-boat efficiency: a 24.5 gal fuel tank that supports relaxed cruising without complicating range considerations.

## Questions and Answers

Q1: What are the dimensions of the 25 GL? A1: The **Length overall (LOA)** is 25 ft (7.72 m) and the **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m).

Q2: What powers the boat? A2: It is propelled by 1 **Yamaha outboard** that

runs on **gas** , matching the simple operation expected of a motor yacht in a pontoon layout.

Q3: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A3: The **hull** is constructed of aluminum, and the **deck** is also **aluminum** .

Q4: What is the fuel capacity? A4: The **fuel capacity** is 24.5 gallons, well suited to relaxed day outings.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly choose the 25 GL from BENNINGTON for family-friendly cruising and entertaining because the layouts accommodate roughly 10–13 people with expansive lounges and convenient table/galley arrangements for day trips. Features like pillow-top seating, Seagrass flooring, and in-floor compartments make it simple to stow coolers and water toys while maintaining a tidy deck.

On the water, the [25 GL] delivers a smooth, confident ride for a pontoon, with composed handling at cruising speeds. Real-world performance depends on chosen propulsion and load: many examples carry 150–250+ HP and owners often prefer 200–250 HP for a full complement and watersports, noting that 150 HP may feel underpowered when fully loaded. Comfort and practicality are strong points, but some practical issues appear over time. Under-seat and in-floor storage are valued, yet batteries located beneath the floor can reduce usable space and complicate service access. Reports on upholstery durability vary (including seam wear, fading, or tears), and there are occasional mentions

of seam failures, pontoon weld or leak repairs, or trim issues; warranty results differ by dealer and ownership history. Periodic electrical or wiring concerns are noted in owner conversations, and long-term parts/service for Evinrude-powered boats has been a point of concern compared with the generally easier support path for Yamaha or Mercury.

## Pros and Cons

- Generous social layout that comfortably seats 10–13 passengers with lounges and day-cruise conveniences.
- A smooth, confident pontoon ride with steady, composed handling at cruise.
- Flexible power choices; 200–250 HP setups handle full loads and watersports well.
- With 150 HP, overall performance can feel strained when the boat is fully loaded.
- Upholstery lifespan is inconsistent, and some owners report seam problems or occasional pontoon weld/leak repairs.
- Battery placement under the floor reduces available storage and complicates maintenance access.
