Its catamaran hull layout and aluminum decking deliver confidence on day trips, and a single Yamaha outboard keeps mechanical complexity low. As a pontoon boat classified among motor yacht offerings, it's an accessible option for buyers seeking comfort and simplicity.

- Q: What is the **engine** setup on the 257L Pontoon Boat? A: The boat is propelled by a single Yamaha **outboard** running on **Gas/Petrol** , which keeps maintenance and operation straightforward.
- Q: What **speed** can I expect? A: Expect a comfortable cruise speed near **15 kn (15 mph)** and a top speed around **18 kn (18 mph)** .
- Q: What is the **hull type** and material? A: It uses a catamaran hull arrangement constructed with an aluminum hull and an aluminum deck, well

suited to the pontoon boat configuration.

• Q: What is the **fuel capacity** and what does it support? A: The vessel carries **26 gal** of fuel, which is appropriate for normal **day boating** within its cruising range.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly choose the 257L Pontoon Boat from BENNINGTON for family outings and relaxed days on inland waters. Listings and owner reports indicate capacity for roughly a dozen passengers, an expansive open deck area, multiple bench arrangements, bow and stern gates, plus day cruise conveniences such as a bimini, AM/FM stereo, plentiful cupholders, and cooler storage. On the water, the boat delivers a stable, heavier feeling ride that remains composed in light chop, making it straightforward to entertain groups. Performance varies by setup: some tritoon owners fit 90–150 hp packages for mixed use and light towing; with a 150 hp motor, many have recorded mid 30s mph top speeds while others report nearer 30 mph — differences often tied to prop selection, payload, and trim. Owners frequently tweak props and monitor WOT RPM to restore expected top end performance. Routine maintenance experiences are generally positive when the boat is properly cared for, though community threads note occasional fuel/start issues (for example, starting then stalling when advancing the throttle). Upholstery longevity differs by era—S line/Simtex cushions have been reported to crack or stain over time—and saltwater operation requires diligent rinsing and can hasten wear and depreciation by about 10–15%.

Pros and Cons

- Stable, heavier feel ride that remains composed in light chop.
- Generous deck area and adaptable bench layouts that typically accommodate around a dozen passengers.
- Useful day cruising features including bimini shade, stereo, cupholders, and cooler storage.
- Overall performance and top speed are highly dependent on engine choice, prop selection, load, and trim.
- Older S line/Simtex seating may show cracking or staining over time, often prompting reupholstery.
- Saltwater use raises maintenance demands and can increase depreciation by roughly 10–15%.
