## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What is the exact yacht type of the 450 Convertible? A: It is a versatile motor yacht engineered as a dedicated sport fisherman built on a proven fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The 450 Convertible cruises at **26 kn** (29.92 mph) and can reach a **max speed** of **31 kn** (35.67 mph), offering efficient offshore runs.

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Twin **Caterpillar inboard diesel** engines (2 total) deliver reliable propulsion and balanced handling.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: **LOA** 48 ft (14.7 m), **beam** 14 ft (4.54 m), and **max draft** 4.331 ft (1.32 m) provide capable performance while retaining reasonable marina flexibility.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers frequently describe the 450 Convertible from Bertram Yacht as a multi-use platform. Many listings show it arranged for family cruising with three-cabin/two-head layouts, and it's often used as a weekend vessel thanks to its deep-V hull, roomy salon, and convertible flybridge. It is also commonly specified for sportfishing and charter operations, with cockpit fishboxes, a transom livewell/tuna tubes, and dedicated rigging packages

appearing in seller and broker descriptions.

On the water, owners report a dry, steady ride in moderate seas and note the 450 tends to run relatively flat. It planes quickly with strong low-end torque; a published sea trial with Cat 3196 power recorded about 26 knots at cruise and roughly 30 knots at top, and owners regularly praise its confident handling and seakeeping. One noted issue is that the transom door may admit some water, which then exits via the cockpit scuppers.

Day-to-day ownership benefits from an engine room laid out for serviceability and even engine removal without extensive disassembly, a point owners and brokers appreciate. Listings often reference periodic heavy maintenance such as 1,000-hour services, and older hulls have sometimes undergone repowers or substantial engine work. Forum threads also call out cockpit freezer flooding and transom/cockpit drainage issues, so it's wise to confirm these items during a pre-purchase survey.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Versatile for family cruising, weekend leisure, and sportfishing with cockpit fishboxes and a transom livewell/tuna tubes.
- Dry, steady ride that runs fairly flat with confident handling and quick planing.
- Spacious salon/galley with a raised wet-bar and three-stateroom layouts suited to extended trips.
- Transom door can admit some water, though it drains via cockpit scuppers.
- Routine heavy maintenance, including 1,000-hour services, is part of ownership, especially on older hulls.
- Forum reports note cockpit freezer flooding and drainage concerns that warrant inspection at survey.

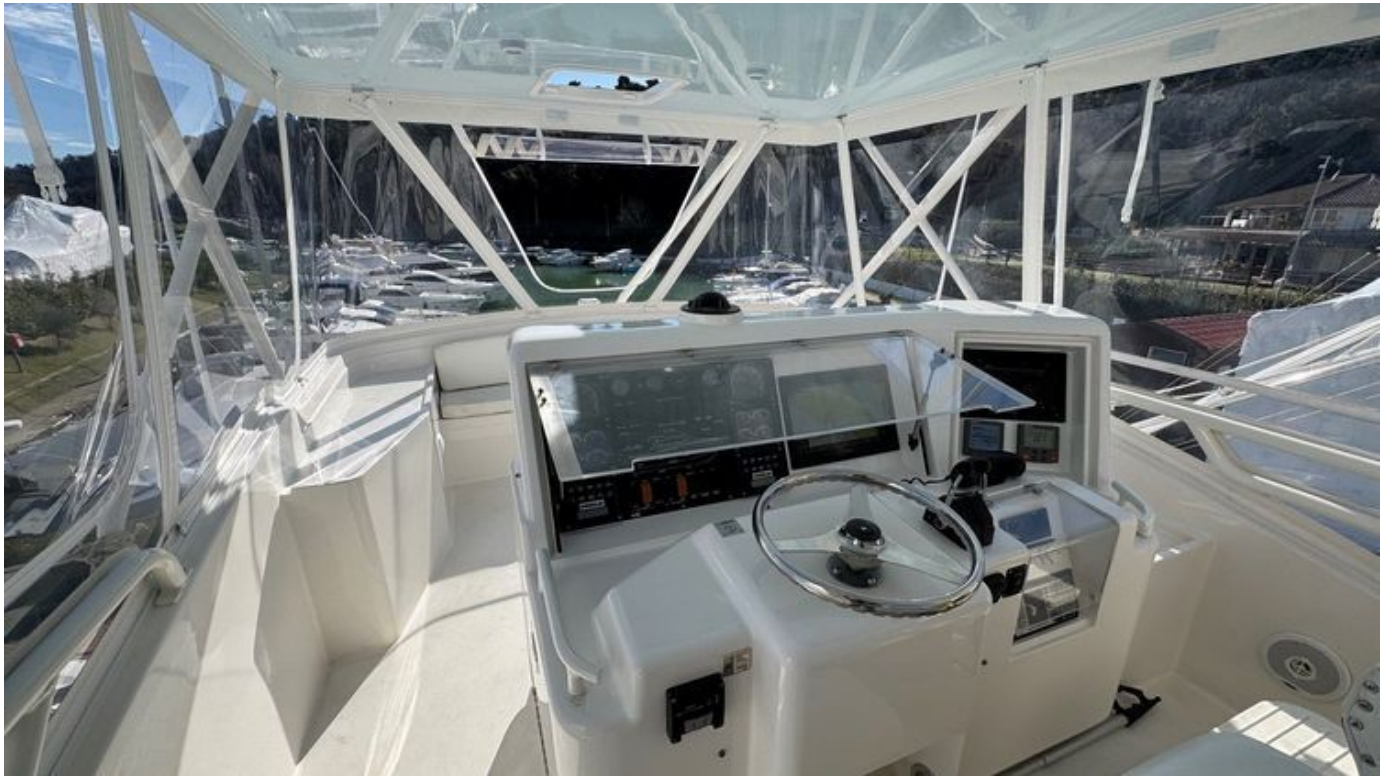
