OVERVIEW

The Convertible from Bertram Yacht is a 60 ft motor yacht originally conceived as a capable sport fisherman. Built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck, it is driven by twin inboard Detroit Diesel powerplants. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the design combines utilitarian fishing features with onboard comforts, featuring three heads and substantial fuel and water reserves.

Selecting a Convertible

Opting for the Convertible makes sense when you want a true sport fisherman that also functions well as a family oriented motor yacht. At 60 ft overall length and a 16 ft beam, paired with significant tankage, the Convertible delivers the size, range, and seagoing capability many owners prioritise.

Features of the Model

- Twin inboard Detroit Diesel propulsion (2 engines) delivering reliable thrust for offshore use
- fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck for long term durability and simplified upkeep
- Three heads fitted to accommodate guests and crew with privacy and convenience
- Massive tankage: 1,630 gallons of fuel plus 250 gallons of fresh water for extended cruising or tournament runs
- Hull and dimensions that strike a balance between responsiveness and stability for dedicated sport fisherman operation

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Convertible? A: It's a motor yacht configured as a sport fisherman with a fiberglass and plastic hull, manufactured by Bertram Yacht.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures 60 ft (18.29 m), the

beam is 16 ft (5.16 m), and the maximum **draft** is 18.045 ft (5.5 m).

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from two **engines** by Detroit Diesel, installed as **Inboard** units and running on **diesel** fuel.

Q: What are the tank capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 1,630 gallons while **water capacity** is 250 gallons.

Q: How many onboard heads and who can I contact to buy? A: The vessel has **3 heads** . For **pricing** and availability, contact Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov regarding the Convertible by Bertram Yacht.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers commonly describe the Convertible by Bertram Yacht as a genuine dual purpose vessel: a tournament capable offshore sportfisher that also accommodates family cruising and longer passages. Reviews often highlight the normal three cabin/three head layouts, a large cockpit, and an expansive salon and galley, with the generous fuel and water reserves enabling weekend trips or bluewater legs when managed conservatively.

Underway, the model's deep V pedigree is frequently commended for delivering a comfortable ride in challenging seas and a reputation as a "fish raiser." Conversely, community reports note sensitivity to trim and weight distribution—particularly when the yacht is heavily laden—so buyers should evaluate balance carefully during survey and sea trial. Many older examples show interiors that require updating and often undergo significant refits; common owner feedback includes high fuel consumption, intermittent major service on large diesels, and occasional structural/fiberglass and systems concerns in some production years. Overall, the platform appeals strongly to anglers and cruising couples who value offshore performance and are prepared for the maintenance associated with a classic large convertible.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V hullform provides a confident, well regarded ride in rough conditions.
- Robust offshore sportfishing platform with a listing and review reputation as a “proven fish raiser.”
- Three cabin/three head configurations, roomy salon and cockpit, and large tankage make it suitable for family cruising and extended trips.
- Older large diesel installation means relatively high fuel consumption and ongoing maintenance costs.
- Sensitivity to trim and weight distribution can cause handling complaints when the vessel is heavily loaded.
- Reports of structural/fiberglass and systems issues on certain years suggest a thorough survey and contingency budget are prudent.
