- What defines the Bilgin 156 in its class? The Bilgin 156 is distinguished by its 155 ft LOA and 499 GT of internal volume married to a steel hull for enhanced

durability; Unique Yacht Design and the Bilgin Design Team combine to deliver a yacht focused on **comfort** , **efficiency** , and meticulous **craftsmanship** .

- Who builds the Bilgin 156 and who are the designers? The yacht is produced by Bilgin Yachts with naval architecture by **Unique Yacht Design** and interiors completed by the **Bilgin Design Team** , ensuring integrated **engineering** and cohesive styling.

- How does the Bilgin 156 perform underway? Underway, anticipate an economical **cruise speed** around 11 kn (12.66 mph) and a **maximum** near 16 kn (18.41 mph), powered by **twin MTU inboard diesel** engines—providing the steady passagemaking expected from a capable motor yacht.

- What capacity and accommodation does the Bilgin 156 offer?

Accommodations are arranged for **up to 10** guests, backed by significant tankage of approximately **17,831.61 gal fuel** and **3,064.4 gal water** , enabling extended cruising without frequent resupply.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners often select the Bilgin 156 for true long-distance cruising rather than outright speed. With a full-displacement steel hull penned by Unique Yacht Design, published performance targets show roughly an 11–12-knot cruising pace, a top speed near 16 knots, and an approximate range of 3,500–4,000 nm when run at about 12 knots. The emphasis is on calm seakeeping and onboard comfort; many examples include fin and gyro stabilizers and survey histories that reflect routine servicing of those systems.

Inside, typical arrangements provide five guest cabins in addition to an owner's suite—often sited on the main deck—and some builds feature a fold-out

balcony. Standard sleeping capacity is about 10, with certain layouts accommodating up to 12. Interior ambiance tends to be light and contemporary thanks to large hull windows, though finish levels differ between hulls. Commonly fitted extras include a transom-access beach club, a gym, several alfresco dining zones, and one or two Jacuzzi installations depending on the specific build.

Practical operation benefits from thoughtful service routing and later hulls show galley and pantry refinements that enhance crew movement and guest privacy. For ownership planning, periodic maintenance is a reality for a 47–48 m displacement yacht: five-year surveys on recent examples commonly list new seawater and chilled-water pumps, new condenser coils, cleaned heat exchangers, turbocharger and fuel-injector servicing, stabilizer bearing work, genset electrical-end replacements, and driveline maintenance such as shaft pulling and propeller reconditioning. The model also fits commercial programs well, since it can be registered for charter under 500 GT, provided owners keep to diligent, scheduled maintenance.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Long-range capability with a published ~3,500–4,000 nm range at about 12 knots.
- Comfortable seakeeping provided by a full-displacement steel hull and fin/gyro stabilization.
- Flexible use: interior arrangements and amenities suit family cruising and the yacht can be registered for commercial charter under 500 GT.
- Relatively modest top-end speed for a yacht of this size, typically around an ~11–12-knot cruise and ~16-knot maximum.
- Stabilizer and hydraulic systems require recurring overhauls and attentive servicing.
- Five-year survey items can be extensive, indicating significant ongoing

ownership costs and planned periods out of service.
