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OVERVIEW

The BILGIN 170 from Bilgin Yachts is a 170 ft (52 m) luxury motor yacht constructed on a steel-hulled platform. With a 30 ft (9.25 m) beam, an 8.53 ft (2.6 m) draft and a gross tonnage of 499 GT, it offers a combination of internal volume and seaworthiness suited to extended cruising. Propulsion is provided by a single CAT engine, delivering a comfortable 12-knot (13.81 mph) cruising pace and a top end near 16 knots (18.41 mph), supported by generous tankage of 14,938 gallons of fuel and 2,969 gallons of potable water.

When evaluating 52-meter options in the motor-yacht segment, the BILGIN 170 differentiates itself through its steel construction, a single-engine propulsion philosophy, and proportions that balance draft with beam for capable seakeeping. Owner Experience Review

Initial feedback from the first hull suggests the BILGIN 170 fulfills its brief as a sub-500 GT, long-range family cruiser with strong credentials for social entertaining. The internal arrangement accommodates up to 12 guests and nine crew with clear separation of guest and crew zones; published layouts reference an owner's suite on the bridge deck with a private balcony, a full-beam master, a main-deck VIP, plus four guest cabins. Generous exterior living areas — including a sundeck with a jacuzzi reported to seat up to eight and a large beach club with fold-down terraces — emphasize its role as an entertainment-focused platform and support a charter-capable six-cabin configuration. Designer Emrecan Özgün described the concept as aiming for "a yacht that is both a personal statement and a social hub," and the owner's representative called the collaboration with Bilgin Yachts among his best project experiences.

Underway, the displacement steel hull with an aluminum superstructure carries forward evolution from the Bilgin 163 platform, prioritizing seakeeping

and fuel efficiency over outright top speed; reported figures indicate a top speed around 16 knots with normal cruising conducted at more economical, lower speeds. The first unit was delivered in 2026 following a technical launch and sea trials, and long-term handling and maintenance feedback over multiple seasons is not yet available. That said, the series was developed by Bilgin Yachts to be familiar and straightforward to operate while remaining under 500 GT, which should align with established yard service practices; however, the high level of bespoke outfitting can introduce system complexity and may require specialized servicing as time goes on.

Pros and Cons

- Long-range displacement platform with a steel hull derived from the Bilgin 163, emphasizing seakeeping and onboard comfort.
- Accommodation plan for up to 12 guests and nine crew across six cabins fits both private ownership and charter use.
- Large exterior entertaining areas, including a sundeck with jacuzzi and a beach club with fold-down terraces, enhance social use.
- Too recent for comprehensive long-term reliability and maintenance trends; the first unit was delivered in 2026.
- Independent, multi-season sea-keeping and handling reports are limited beyond initial builder trials.
- High-spec, bespoke systems can increase operational complexity and the requirement for specialized servicing.
