OVERVIEW

The 256 Bay from BLACKJACK is a 25-foot motor yacht built on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck. It's powered by a single Mercury Outboard and runs on Gas/Petrol, offering a simple, dependable propulsion package and an 80-gallon fuel tank to sustain full days afloat. Shestakov Yacht Sales represents the model, with broker Andrey Shestakov available to guide you from initial inquiry through delivery.

Selecting a 256 Bay

If you're evaluating a nimble 25-footer, the 256 Bay delivers workable dimensions paired with uncomplicated, well-proven power. Key considerations as you decide include:

- LOA of 25 ft (7.77 m) for straightforward handling and storage logistics.
 - Maximum draft of 5.468 ft (1.6666 m) to match the waterways you plan to frequent.
 - Single Mercury Outboard running on Gas/Petrol for ease of maintenance and reliable operation.
 - Composite build: a fiberglass and plastic hull topped with a fiberglass deck.

Q: Is the 256 Bay considered a motor yacht? A: Yes. It is listed in the motor yacht category, combining a single **Outboard** installation with sensible overall proportions.

ft (7.77 m) , which aids in maneuverability and mooring or storage planning.

Q: What type of **engine** does it use, and what is the **fuel** ? A: The boat is equipped with a single **Mercury Outboard** and operates on **Gas/Petrol** .

Q: What are the **draft** and construction details? A: Maximum draft measures **5.468 ft (1.6666 m)** . The hull is constructed from fiberglass and plastic and the deck is fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners report using the 256 Bay from BLACKJACK across a range of activities including inshore and nearshore bay fishing, guiding charters, and leisure days at sandbars with family. The flexible layout—featuring removable forward seating—and uncluttered deck plan make it an adaptable dayboat, and multiple owners compliment the fit-and-finish and freedom of movement on deck. Professional guides note the cockpit area remains roomy enough that four clients feel comfortable, while the front-opening console contributes valuable storage and space for an optional head and battery stowage.

Practical fishing features cited by owners include rod storage, an insulated livewell, and several dry compartments, all supporting productive days on the water. In operation, feedback consistently praises a very dry ride and a sturdy hull that manages open-water chop with composure—several owners describe its tracking as if it were "on rails." One owner reported a setup with a Yamaha 300 and a T-top reaching 51 mph. Maintenance comments are pragmatic: dark-colored gelcoat requires extra care, though one charter operator said applying a ceramic coating reduced washdowns to roughly once a month. A

few owners also mention display and calibration oddities with Yamaha 6YC fuel-flow/trim readouts. Other practical notes include the boat feeling long on the trailer at times, with dealer and factory responsiveness generally rated positively when issues or questions arise.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, confident ride in bay chop reported by multiple owners.
- Adaptable, roomy deck suitable for guides and families, with removable forward seating and ample fishing-oriented storage.
- Owners report responsive dealer and factory support.
- Dark gelcoat requires more maintenance; some owners mitigate this with a ceramic coating to lower wash frequency.
- A number of owners have observed electronics/display calibration quirks (for example, Yamaha 6YC fuel-flow/trim readouts).
- Trailer length and ramp handling can feel awkward during launching and retrieval.

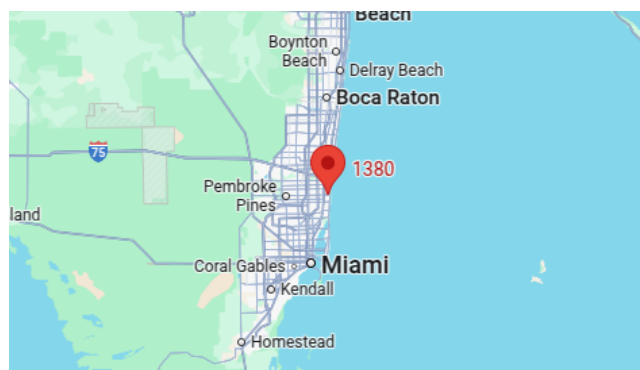
