The BLUE WAVE 2400 Pure Bay is a 24 ft (7.32 m) motor yacht configured as a center console layout built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and powered by a single Suzuki outboard.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners are drawn to the 2400 Pure Bay from BLUE WAVE for its capability in inshore waters and a composed, confidence-inspiring ride. Several owner reports highlight its ability to handle chop with a dry feel and to soften the impact of larger wakes—many buyers say that the way it rides was the deciding factor. With a 300 HP setup it planes readily; published test figures suggest an economical cruise near ~34 mph at roughly 4 MPG and a top speed approaching 60 mph. The consensus among many owners is to opt for the 300 HP package for the best performance and resale appeal.

Day-to-day operation favors anglers while remaining accommodating to family use. Reviewers praise the large forward and aft casting platforms, ample lockable rod storage, and well-placed insulated fish boxes. Newer PureBay consoles are taller to accept larger electronics, and the helm area offers multiple layouts to balance livewell, cooler, and tackle storage. Convertible stern jump seats and optional Cyclone/full-bucket helm seating add comfort for sandbar gatherings, casual weekend cruising, or guide-style fishing trips.

Reliability feedback is generally positive—one long-term owner observed that after several years the boat had been trouble-free. That said, owners commonly note some preventive maintenance items: deck and console caulking may dry out over time and will need occasional resealing; black gelcoat tends to reveal scratches and water marks, so frequent washing and waxing are necessary; and prospective buyers should inspect rigging and wiring routing to ensure harnesses are neatly arranged during setup.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Dry, composed ride in chop that owners often prefer to other 24' bay boats.
- Potent with 300 HP: quick to plane, ~34 mph cruise at around ~4 MPG, and

about 60 mph top speed.

- Angler-oriented yet family-capable layout with expansive casting decks, plentiful rod storage, insulated fish boxes, and convertible jump seats.
- Deck/console caulking can dry-rot over time and may require periodic resealing.
- Black hulls show scratches and water spots easily, necessitating frequent washing and waxing.
- Rigging quality varies; inspect wiring harness routing and neatness during setup.

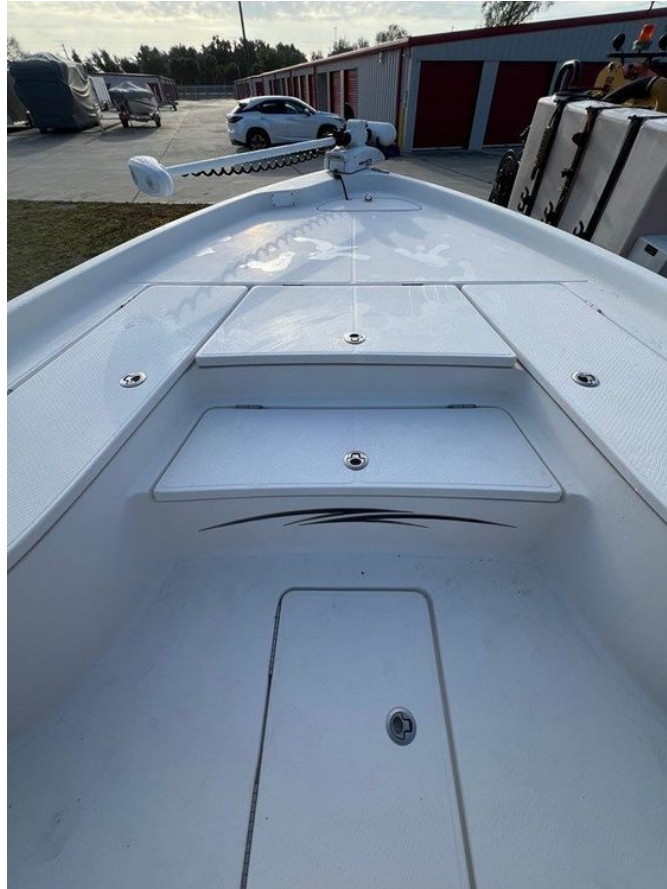
