OVERVIEW

The Center Console Hybrid from BLUE WAVE combines spirited performance with everyday day boat practicality on a confident 28 foot platform. This adaptable center console yacht sits within the broader motor yachts segment and rides on a robust fiberglass-and-plastic hull. Offered by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, it's configured for quick runs, low stress ownership, and memorable days afloat.

Selecting a Center Console Hybrid

Picking the right 28 footer is a question of compromises and priorities. The Center Console Hybrid presents an LOA of 28 ft (8.53 m) with a 9 ft (2.79 m) beam for steady handling, paired with a single Suzuki outboard to keep maintenance straightforward. Its minimum draft of 4.648 ft (1.4166 m) and a 96 gallon fuel tank make it well suited for flexible day boating plans. If you value the utility of a center console layout built on a dependable motor yacht platform, arrange a viewing with Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Q: What type of yacht is the Center Console Hybrid? A: It's a flexible center console yacht within the motor yachts class, constructed on a sturdy fiberglass-and-plastic hull to provide **reliability** and **low maintenance** .

Q: What performance can I expect? A: Anticipate a **cruising speed** of approximately 35 kn (35 mph) and a **top speed** in the vicinity of 52 kn (52 mph), enabling brisk point to point runs and efficient day trips.

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: The boat is propelled by a **single outboard** from **Suzuki** , fueled by **Gas/Petrol** , emphasizing simplicity and straightforward **service** .

Q: What comfort and capacity features stand out? A: The layout includes 1 **head** for privacy and a **fuel capacity** of 96 gallons to support active day long outings without frequent refueling.

Owner Experience Review

Owners who divide time between bay flats, near coastal runs, and family outings say the Center Console Hybrid from BLUE WAVE performs those roles without feeling compromised. Raised forward casting decks make sight casting on shallow flats easier, and the overall arrangement adapts well to longer day trips offshore or relaxed cruising with friends and family aboard.

On the water, reports describe a twin stepped hull that "rode happily across waves from every direction" in a sloppy, confused three foot sea, cutting

through with minimal spray over the rub rail for a notably dry and confidence boosting ride. Published test numbers include examples near 55 MPH top speed with a Suzuki DF350 and fuel consumption around 3 MPG at roughly 34 MPH; owners generally view those figures as useful reference points rather than absolute guarantees, since rigging and load significantly affect results.

Comfort and fishability are frequent compliments: Llebroc helm seats with flip bolsters earn praise, and a sizable tackle center under the seating keeps gear tidy. The forward casting deck plus ample dry storage (rod lockers and insulated fish boxes) accommodate multi angler trips, while the roomy console permits adult access to onboard systems. Serviceability is another positive, with a wide port giving easy access to pumps and below deck systems; still, used listings and forum discussions note isolated warranty incidents (including lower unit repairs covered under warranty) and mixed dealer responsiveness—some owners report seamless support, others have experienced occasional parts or warranty delays.

Pros and Cons

- Twin stepped hull produces a soft, dry ride and, in test conditions, managed a sloppy three foot chop with confidence.
- Genuine hybrid utility for the missions the Center Console Hybrid from BLUE WAVE targets: bay/inshore sight casting, near coastal/offshore day trips, and family cruising.
- Angler and crew oriented ergonomics with comfortable Llebroc bolstered helm seating, a large tackle center, and plentiful dry storage.
- Owner feedback indicates varied dealer and warranty experiences depending on market timing and location.
- Secondary market listings mention isolated service items, including lower unit work or replacements that were addressed under warranty.

• Published performance and fuel economy numbers come from specific review configurations and will vary with rigging, load, and environmental conditions.
