Q: Who is the builder of the 160 Super Sport? A: The builder is Boston Whaler, and the model is listed as a motor yacht.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures 16 ft (4.88 m), the **Beam** is 6 ft (2.11 m), and the **Draft** (max) is 3.007 ft (0.9166 m).

Q: What is the engine setup? A: It is equipped with **1 Mercury outboard** engine running on **Gas** .

Q: What is the fuel capacity? A: The **fuel capacity** is 13 gal.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The **hull** is constructed of fiberglass and plastic, and the **deck** is Fiberglass. For material specifics and category information, contact Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically deploy the 160 Super Sport from Boston Whaler for family day trips and short coastal excursions—activities like beach hopping, nearshore fishing from the small casting area, and towing a tube or light skier when fitted with the 90 hp option. Its trailerable nature and easy launchability make it a true 16 foot load and go craft. The refreshed Super Sport lineup that introduced this model arrived around 2019, and the model has remained in production since.

On the water the boat is lively and engaging to pilot, offering a playful slide through tight turns and very little cavitation even when pushed hard. Recorded performance shows time-to-plane of roughly 3.2 seconds, an efficient cruising range between about 16 and 22 mph, and a top speed near 37 mph with 75–90 hp—numbers that suit its intended short-trip uses. The compromise comes with ride comfort: multiple owners report the boat feels small and a bit unsettled in chop, and it is not ideal for seas greater than about 2 feet.

Aboard, the lockable helm/console storage is a frequent highlight—secure for valuables though modest in size—and the flexible seating, under seat storage, and optional bow cushion make the layout functional for 3–4 adults. Space is tighter than on larger center consoles, and ownership reports include some quality concerns such as bow gunnel gelcoat cracking and at least one instance of a helm seat detaching, alongside mixed experiences with warranty response. Routine access to and servicing of the outboard is simple, and many owners advise thorough dealer prep and inspection at delivery.

Pros and Cons

- Responsive, enjoyable handling with minimal cavitation during hard turns.
- Practical performance: approximately 3.2 s to plane, efficient 16–22 mph cruise, and roughly 37 mph top speed with 75–90 hp.
- Trailerable and versatile for family day outings, nearshore fishing, and light watersports when equipped with the 90 hp option.
- Can feel small and unsettled in chop; not ideal for conditions over about 2 feet.
- Limited passenger room compared with larger center consoles—best for 3–4 adults.
- Owner reported issues include gelcoat cracking and at least one detached helm seat, with varied warranty support experiences.
