Selecting a 220 Outrage

Opting for a 220 Outrage reflects a preference for simplicity, reliable performance, and minimal maintenance. The single outboard layout reduces servicing tasks and preserves an uncluttered cockpit ideal for both fishing and family outings. If your brief calls for a compact motor yacht with a Deep Vee hull tailored to the sport fisherman market, the 220 Outrage from Boston Whaler is a focused, no-nonsense choice.

Q: What type of boat is the 220 Outrage? A: The 220 Outrage is a compact motor yacht designed for the sport fisherman niche, constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull and featuring a Deep Vee hull form to deliver a confident, stable ride. Notable characteristics include a **Deep Vee** hull and a layout optimized for **day use** activities.

Q: What is the engine setup on this model? A: Power on the 220 Outrage is

provided by a single **Mercury outboard** running on **gas** . This simple propulsion arrangement favors efficient cruising performance and easier routine maintenance.

Q: What are the size details I should know? A: Dimensional data for the model list an **LOA** of 22 ft (6.83 m) and a **beam** of 8 ft (2.59 m), offering a stable, practical platform for both fishing and family day trips.

Q: What onboard capacities and amenities are included? A: The vessel carries a **fuel capacity** of 115 gal, a **water capacity** of 20 gal, and includes 1 **head** , meeting basic needs for day excursions and shorter overnight outings.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly use the 220 Outrage as a versatile center-console: a weekday family dayboat that converts into a weekend fishing machine. Renters and private owners frequently praise its family-safe reputation, with a layout that supports comfortable bow seating over storage lockers and a forward-facing cooler seat. A height-adjustable leaning post, a cockpit adaptable for angling or lounging, a standard 20 gallon livewell, and optional rod holders simplify transitions between fishing mode and relaxation.

On the water, professional testers have described it as one of the smoothest, driest rides available in an open Boston Whaler, and owners report confident handling in choppy conditions thanks to a pronounced V that slices through waves. Trial data with a Mercury Verado 225 showed a top speed near 45.8

mph and a relaxed cruise around 26.5 mph at 4,000 rpm. Low-speed steering feel is reported as solid, and maneuvering back onto a trailer in a crosscurrent is generally straightforward.

Typical propulsion choices include a single Verado 225/250/300 or twin 115s; many boats are equipped with SmartCraft/DTS electronics and systems. These powerplants require the recommended fuel octane and adherence to scheduled service intervals. Routine access to the outboard makes common maintenance tasks manageable, and there are no widely reported model-specific failures beyond ordinary rigging, electrical, and seal maintenance and the expected Verado service costs. Most listings show open center-console configurations, with only a minority featuring a basic cuddy, so onboard cabin volume is limited compared with larger Outrage variants.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, dry ride for an open boat noted in expert testing.
- Family-friendly, versatile layout with bow seating, storage, and a height-adjustable leaning post.
- Capable performance with a 225 Verado: about 45.8 mph top and ~26.5 mph cruise per tests.
- Limited cabin space versus larger Outrage models; most boats are open center consoles.
- Mercury Verado systems demand proper fuel and scheduled service, with costs typical for this engine family.
- Rated Design Category C, so plan within coastal and inshore conditions.
