OVERVIEW

The 315 Conquest from Boston Whaler is a multi-purpose motor yacht featuring a genuine walkaround type layout built on a Deep Vee hull fashioned from fiberglass and plastic. Measuring 31 ft (9.45 m) overall with a 10 ft (3.25 m) beam, it combines offshore capability with comfortable accommodations suited to family use.

Selecting a 315 Conquest

Opting for the 315 Conquest means choosing a well-rounded platform. Its twin Boston Whaler–specified Mercury outboards (2) running on **gas/petrol** provide lively response, while the Deep Vee hull contributes to confident handling across a variety of seas. As a compact motor yacht in the walkaround type category, it is ideal for anglers, weekend cruisers, and active families who prize unobstructed deck movement and straightforward upkeep. The interior sleeps 4 with a single head and supports practical cruising thanks to generous fuel (291 gal) and water (46 gal) tanks—making it suitable for day trips that stretch into comfortable overnights. the walkaround type tradition with a fiberglass and plastic Deep Vee hull for confident handling.

Q: What powers this model? A: Two Mercury outboards provide the **engine** drive, using **gas/petrol** fuel for straightforward operation and service.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard? A: The layout provides **accommodation** for up to 4 with 1 **head** , making weekend cruising practical.

Owner Experience Review

Owners describe the 315 Conquest from Boston Whaler as a genuine crossover vessel—equally at home on family overnights, serious offshore fishing excursions, and leisurely day cruises. The cockpit is arranged with anglers in mind, featuring in-deck macerated fishboxes, rod holders, and an optional livewell; entertainment-focused options such as shade packages and a "summer kitchen" make socializing easy. Below decks, the cabin sleeps up to four and includes an enclosed head; the standard galley includes a microwave with a stove available as an option, and the mid-cabin offers an open, comfortable living space. At the helm the captain's seat is generous and the dash can accept large electronics, though some owners have pointed out a lack of well-placed cupholders as a minor irritation.

On the water, sea trials and owner feedback highlight a soft, solid ride that tracks true through confused 3–4 ft seas, delivering a settled cruise feel at

moderate speeds. The twin outboards provide strong performance, but owners note fuel burn can be relatively high at elevated RPMs. Maintenance access scores well thanks to a large center cockpit hatch giving ready entry to the mechanical bay (serving the macerator and bilge pumps, fuel manifolds, battery banks, and an optional generator). Conversely, owners have reported generator saltwater-flow switch fouling and intermittent electrical/generator reliability problems that sometimes required repeated dealer visits and lengthy repair windows; there are also sanitation and freshwater complaints, including VacuFlush discharge failures and swollen tanks, in addition to the expected costs of maintaining twin high-hp outboards.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile fish/cruise capability with cockpit layout, in-deck macerated fishboxes, rod holders, and an optional livewell.
- Comfortable, solid ride with precise tracking that handles 3–4 ft seas well.
- Cabin comfort for family overnights with sleeping for up to four, an enclosed head, and a galley with microwave and optional stove.
- Relatively high fuel consumption at high RPM despite strong twin-outboard performance.
- Owner reports of generator and electrical reliability issues, including saltwater-flow switch fouling and lengthy dealer repair turnarounds.
- Sanitation and freshwater system complaints, including VacuFlush discharge failures and swollen tanks.

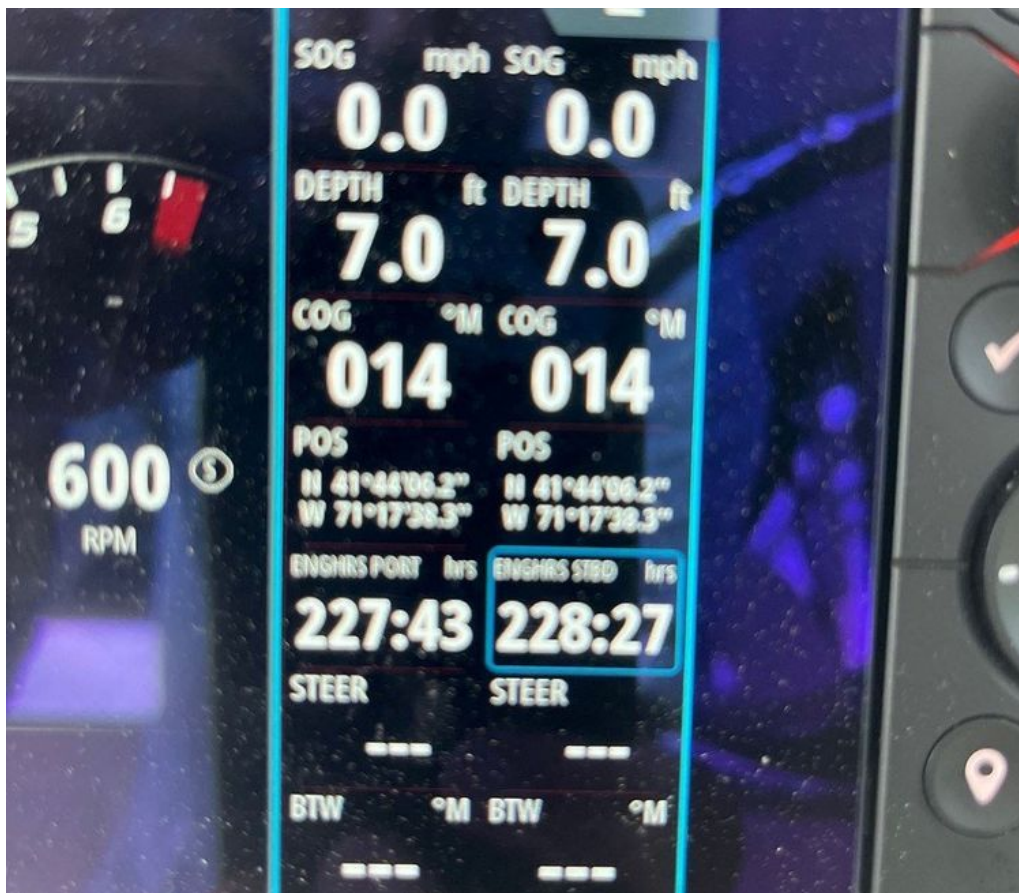
