OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales, the BUDDY DAVIS 34 CC is a multi-purpose center console built as a capable motor yacht on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. For purchase guidance and detailed inquiries, connect directly with broker Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 34 CC

If your priority is a practical, easy-to-maintain center console yacht with dependable propulsion, the 34 CC warrants consideration. It commonly comes with twin Yamaha outboards using gas, a substantial 300-gallon fuel bunker, and a 64-gallon freshwater tank — a combination suited to day trips and nearshore passages. Measuring 34 ft (10.36 m) LOA with a 10 ft (3.2 m) beam, this hull offers a good compromise between nimble handling and usable deck area while fitting squarely in the motor yacht category.

Features of the Model

- Center console design: An open-deck layout that follows the center console concept, allowing unrestricted 360-degree movement around the cockpit.
- Propulsion: Twin Yamaha outboards powered by **gas**, chosen for dependable operation and straightforward upkeep.
- Dimensions: **LOA** 34 ft (10.36 m), **beam** 10 ft (3.2 m), **draft (max)** 9.569 ft (2.9166 m).
- Capacities: **Fuel** 300 gal, **fresh water** 64 gal to support extended day use.
- Construction: Built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a **Fiberglass** deck that delivers durability and a refined finish.

- What engines does it use and what fuel type? This model is equipped with **two Yamaha outboards** that operate on **gas**, chosen for ease of use and routine maintenance.

Owner Experience Review

Owners describe the BUDDY DAVIS 34 CC as a genuine crossover platform: a fully fishable offshore craft with 360-degree access that also serves well for sandbar gatherings and family day cruises. The layout's open deck, oversized fishboxes, livewells, and a dedicated tackle center support active fishing, while optional forward seating converts the boat into a more leisurely arrangement. Inside the console there is roughly 6'6" of headroom, with a head, sink, and handheld shower, and the finish work—such as AwlGrip touches and custom details—creates a larger yacht ambiance in a 34 foot package.

On the water, reviewers consistently reference the 24° deep V hull and marked Carolina bow flare that effectively slice through chop, maintain tracking in following seas, and produce a stable, “rides-on-rails” feel offshore. When fitted with higher horsepower—commonly triple 300s—the 34 CC accelerates onto plane briskly and sustains a fast, comfortable cruise for extended day runs.

From an ownership perspective, the hinged console face that tilts aft simplifies

access to wiring and electronics. Prospective buyers weighing twin versus triple setups should bear in mind that triple outboard configurations raise ongoing service frequency and operating expenses, and—given examples that span approximately 2006–2019 with a noted 2016 update—should carefully confirm options and engine hours through listings and maintenance records.

Pros and Cons

- Confident offshore ride delivered by the 24° deep V hull and pronounced Carolina bow flare, which cut chop and track well in following seas.
- True 360° fishability with large fishboxes, livewells, and a proper tackle center supports dedicated sportfishing.
- Console offering about 6'6" of headroom plus a head, sink, and handheld shower provides genuine day cruising and occasional overnight comfort.
- Triple outboard installations increase service complexity and operating costs compared with twin-engine setups.
- Equipment and interior/exterior layouts vary across production years and option packages, so buyers need to verify features such as forward seating and triple engine rigging.
- Performance and cruise character are highly dependent on installed horsepower; twin configurations feel different from the popular triple 300 arrangements.

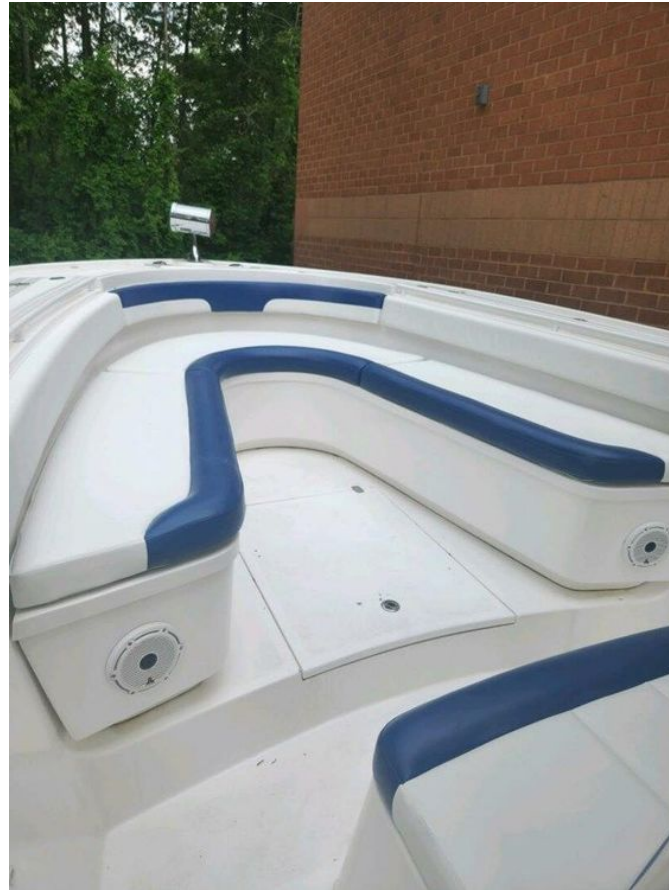
