Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 40 Express from Cabo Yachts merges the seaworthiness of a motor yacht with the dedicated utility of a sport-fisherman, built on a time-tested fiberglass construction hull. Led by Andrey Shestakov and supported by our international team, we can help you assess this platform for serious angling as well as comfortable short cruises.

### Selecting a 40 Express

---

If your priority is a compact vessel tailored for fishing that still delivers true cruising comforts, the 40 Express deserves close consideration. Measuring 40 ft LOA (12.19 m) with a generous 15 ft (4.78 m) beam, it offers a balance of offshore stability and livable interior volume. Twin **MAN** engines running on **diesel** provide redundancy for long transits to productive grounds, while sleeping arrangements for up to **4** and **1 head** make weekend outings realistic. Fuel and water reserves— **550 gal** and **95 gal** , respectively—support extended fishing excursions and short cruises. As a motor yacht configured in the sport fisherman mold, it will suit owners who demand fishing capability without abandoning creature comforts.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 40 Express? A: It is a motor yacht built with a

pronounced sport-fisherman layout, constructed on a robust fiberglass construction hull by Cabo Yachts.

Q: What are the key dimensions I should know? A: The **LOA** measures 40 ft (12.19 m), the **beam** is 15 ft (4.78 m), and the minimum **draft** is 11.209 ft (3.4166 m), yielding a stable platform suitable for fishing and short-range cruising.

Q: What powers the boat and what fuel does it use? A: Propulsion comes from **twin MAN** powerplants that operate on **diesel**, offering reliable performance and range for offshore runs.

Q: How many people can stay aboard comfortably? A: The layout provides **accommodations** for up to **4** guests with **1 head**, which fits the needs of anglers or small family groups on weekend trips.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers regularly describe the 40 Express by Cabo Yachts as a flexible vessel that marries tournament-grade fishing capability with family-oriented cruising amenities. The cockpit is frequently highlighted as class-leading at roughly 100 sq ft, equipped with in-deck fishboxes, insulated storage, and a layout optimized for bait preparation—features that make it well suited for competitive fishing days. The interior finish earns praise as well: teak-and-holly soles, Corian countertops in the galley, and a practical arrangement that enhances livability, while the bridgedeck's proximity to the cockpit promotes a sociable onboard environment. Overnight arrangements include a private forward queen stateroom plus a salon settee that converts

into upper/lower berths, covering common weekend needs.

Underway evaluations point to strong sea-keeping characteristics, delivering a dry ride that tracks confidently downsea and copes well with closely spaced waves; one reviewer captured the feeling with the line “it just plain ate it up.” Normal cruising speeds are reported in the 28–31 knot range, with some higher-power **MAN** installations reaching the low-to-mid 30s. Boats equipped with Zeus/pod drives are often singled out for exceptional maneuverability, offering near-dock control and precise station-keeping—the “skyhook” capability is a frequent compliment. Overall, the 40 is regarded as nimble and very responsive.

From a maintenance perspective, owners appreciate the boat’s serviceability: tidy, labeled wiring, well-thought-out plumbing, and logical engine-room organization all contribute to faster servicing and simpler troubleshooting. That said, Zeus/pod drivetrains bring extra complexity and potential cost when compared with straight-shaft configurations, and many used listings note lifecycle items such as trim-cylinder servicing on pods and occasional generator replacement or upgrade. Most buyers find the clean systems layout helps mitigate routine maintenance burdens.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Excellent sea-keeping with a dry ride that tracks well downsea and handles tightly packed seas.
- Class-leading cockpit (about 100 sq ft) with in-deck fishboxes and insulated storage for serious fishing and social use.
- Zeus/pod-equipped boats offer near-dock control and convenient station-keeping.
- Zeus/pod drives add complexity and potential maintenance cost versus straight shafts.

- Many used examples note generator or drive work over time, reflecting normal lifecycle upkeep.
- Additional sleeping capacity relies on converting the salon settee, adding a step for overnights.
