OVERVIEW

Constructed by Cabo Yachts, the 43 Flybridge is a purpose-built motor yacht engineered for dedicated anglers. It combines a pronounced Deep Vee running surface with a rugged fiberglass construction platform. Offered by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, this model pairs assured offshore capability with livable accommodations for up to five guests overnight.

Selecting a 43 Flybridge

Opt for the 43 Flybridge when your priorities include dependable performance and purposeful fishing features from a respected builder like Cabo Yachts. With a typical cruise of 26 knots (29.92 mph) and a maximum near 35 knots (40.28 mph), driven by twin MAN diesels, and accommodation for five with two heads, it fits anglers and families seeking a motor yacht configured as a true sport fisherman. Its Deep Vee hull and fiberglass build emphasize structural integrity and seaworthiness.

Questions and Answers

Q: What is the cruise and top speed of the 43 Flybridge? A: The vessel cruises at about **26 knots** (29.92 mph) and can reach a **top speed** of roughly 35 knots

(40.28 mph), providing assured offshore performance.

Q: What engines power the boat, and what fuel do they use? A: The yacht is driven by **2 MAN** engines that operate on **Diesel**, a dependable twin configuration for a performance-oriented motor yacht.

Q: What are the key dimensions and fuel capacity? A: The **LOA** measures 43 ft (13.11 m), **beam** is 15 ft (4.6 m), **draft** is 14.217 ft (4.3333 m), and **fuel capacity** is 700.06 gallons.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard, and how many heads are there? A: Accommodations sleep **5** and the layout includes **2 heads**, offering sensible comfort for extended trips.

Q: How is the hull built and configured? A: This model employs a **Deep Vee** hull configuration set on a fiberglass construction foundation, consistent with its role as a sport fisherman in the motor yacht class.

Owner Experience Review

Owners deploy the 43 Flybridge from Cabo Yachts in three principal modes: as a dedicated sportfisher, an owner operated convertible, and a fast weekender. The generous cockpit—with an in deck fishbox, dedicated rigging station and fighting chair provisions—receives consistent commendation from fishermen, while the boat's nimble handling, ability to back and spin, simplifies tight maneuvers. At sea, professional trials and owner reports describe a dry, compliant ride in moderate conditions. Reported performance spans high 20 knot cruising speeds to mid 30s at WOT, though owners frequently emphasize results depend on load, propeller selection and trim; as one owner notes, "With a clean bottom I can only get 26 kts cruise."

For family or coastal cruising, the two stateroom, two head arrangement with a galley down featuring Corian counters has proved functionally comfortable;

the salon is intentionally compact because volume is allocated to the cockpit, yet owners still find the accommodations suitable for overnighting. Easy cockpit access to the engine room and lazarette is a practical advantage for routine maintenance, and community forums report no single recurring structural defect. The trade offs are typical for twin high horsepower MAN/Cat inboards: careful prop selection and tuning matter, fuel and air filter upkeep is important, and routine maintenance and parts costs are higher than for smaller powerplants.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, compliant ride in moderate seas with strong seakeeping characteristics.
- Responsive handling and straightforward close quarters maneuvering ideal for owner operators.
- Substantial cockpit with in deck fishbox, rigging station and fighting chair provisions supports serious sportfishing.
- Salon volume is modest because the design intentionally favors cockpit space.
- Actual cruise speed is influenced by load, choice of props and trim settings.
- Twin high horsepower inboards entail higher routine service and parts expenses compared with smaller installations.
