Its Deep Vee hull, paired with twin Detroit Diesel packages and well-proportioned dimensions (45 ft LOA, 15 ft beam), yields a combination of speed and seakeeping many owners expect from a serious motor yacht in the cruiser segment. Q: What type of yacht is the 45 by Cabo Yachts? A: It is a motor yacht laid out as

a cruiser featuring a **Deep Vee** hull and a **fiberglass composite** construction.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The 45 posts a **cruise speed** of 27 kn (31.07 mph) and a **top speed** of 35 kn (40.28 mph), offering a compromise between speed and fuel economy.

Q: What powers this model? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 x Detroit Diesel engines** running on **Diesel** fuel for consistent, proven performance.

Q: How is the interior arranged for overnighting? A: The layout includes **accommodations for 4** , with **sleeping** for **3** and **1 head** , delivering practical overnight comfort for cruising.

Owner Experience Review

Many owners operate their 45 by Cabo Yachts as serious offshore sportfishing or tournament vessels, with both express and convertible configurations commonly found. On the water, operator feedback frequently notes that the boat "stays where you put it." Handling in tight quarters is reported as responsive and agile, although the abrupt turbo/engine torque at low speeds requires a gentle touch when idling or docking. Typical cruising tends to sit in the high 20-knot band (around 25 knots is often cited as the most efficient), with WOT readings into the low 30s; owners report a generally confident and dry offshore ride, while some inshore or bay chop conditions have produced complaints of pounding.

Belowdecks, owners often praise premium finishes—book matched woodwork, leather details, and upgraded audio systems appearing in many refits. The common two-stateroom, salon-forward plan, combined with a

spacious galley and large settee, makes the yacht well-suited to family outings and weekend stays. Above, the topside offers a generous cockpit of roughly 95 square feet with large fishboxes, a layout appreciated by anglers and entertainers alike and adaptable to day charter or fishing charter operations.

Serviceability rates well thanks to an engine room layout that allows walk-around access to the main engines' outboard sides. Factory power options frequently include Caterpillar 3196/3406 and Cummins QSM series; owners point out the inevitable higher costs associated with heavy diesel servicing and periodic overhauls. Many older examples on the market have undergone significant refits—engine rebuilds, electronics upgrades, and AC replacements are common—so individual condition and supporting documentation can vary considerably from boat to boat.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Many owners report a confident, dry offshore ride.
- Pro: Nimble close-quarters handling with a “stays where you put it” feel and brisk throttle response.
- Pro: Flexible 2-stateroom interior and a large ~95 sq ft cockpit with substantial fishboxes, making it suitable for fishing, family cruising, and charter work.
- Con: Ride impressions are mixed; some report pounding in certain inshore or bay chop conditions.
- Con: The abrupt turbo torque at low speeds calls for careful throttle control when docking.
- Con: Ownership costs can be significant due to heavy diesel service, overhaul requirements, and age-related refits on older vessels.
