OVERVIEW

Crafted by Canados, the 85 is an elegant motor yacht built to the standards of the fiberglass and plastic yachts class. Measuring an LOA of 86 ft (26.48 m), a beam of 21 ft (6.45 m), and a draft of 6.07 ft (1.85 m), it presents a well-proportioned hull with a gross tonnage of 123.81 GT. Twin Caterpillar diesel powerplants provide a comfortable cruise at 18 knots (20.71 mph) and a top speed around 22 knots (25.32 mph). Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 85

Select the 85 when you want a tried-and-tested 86 ft platform from Canados that harmonizes roomy interiors with efficient underway performance. The layout accommodates up to 10 people overall, sleeps 8 guests, provides 5 heads, and includes dedicated crew quarters (2 cabins, 5 beds), making it an ideal choice for extended family cruising or professionally crewed charters. As a motor yacht built on a hull classed among fiberglass and plastic yachts, it strikes a balance between speed, seakeeping ability, and straightforward maintenance.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Canados 85? A: The Canados 85 is a motor yacht

constructed in the fiberglass and plastic yachts category, featuring a **86 ft LOA** and **21 ft beam** that make it well-suited for comfortable cruising.

Q: What are the cruising and top speeds? A: The yacht cruises at **18 knots (20.71 mph)** and achieves a top speed of **22 knots (25.32 mph)** .

Q: How many guests and crew can stay on board? A: Accommodation count is **10** , with **sleeps 8** and **5 heads** . Crew spaces include **2 cabins** with **5 beds** .

Q: What powers the Canados 85? A: Two **Caterpillar diesel** engines (2 x Caterpillar) supply the vessel's propulsion and onboard power.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter clients typically deploy the 85 by Canados for crewed Mediterranean voyages and short family escapes, often favoring the common four-cabin arrangement (master, VIP and two twins) with en-suite heads to accommodate 8–10 persons. The expansive flybridge and roomy aft cockpit are popular for day cruising and watersports; many listings highlight generous tender stowage, attentive crews—particularly good with children—and enthusiastic support for onboard water activities. Repeated positives in owner feedback include the quality of wood joinery and the inviting social deck areas noted during sales and refits.

Underway, owners report typical cruise speeds near 18 knots, with recorded top speeds varying between approximately 22 and 26 knots on some examples; brokers frequently praise the planing-hull's seakeeping and steady behavior in normal Mediterranean conditions. Numerous older hulls have undergone documented refits—from engine overhauls (including “zero hours”

rebuilt) and electronics upgrades to new generators, fresh teak and upholstery, plus mechanical work on shafts, bow thrusters, through-hulls and gangways—while some of the earliest boats were cold-moulded or wooden, a construction type that forums and owners warn requires more vigilant monitoring for leaks and deck/gunwale condition than all GRP builds.

Pros and Cons

- Four-cabin, 8–10-berth arrangement fits family cruising and charter operations well.
- Assured planing hull performance with reported cruising around ~18 kn and top speeds in the ~22–26 kn range in Mediterranean conditions.
- Generous flybridge and aft deck facilitate day trips and watersports, with tasteful wood joinery contributing to a warm onboard atmosphere.
- Older examples frequently need substantial refit work, including engine, electronics, generator, and cosmetic renewals.
- Some earlier hulls were cold-moulded/wooden and typically require closer inspection for leaks and structural wear compared with all GRP yachts.
- Restoring original performance on certain listings can demand major engine overhauls or full repowering.
