Its fiberglass and plastic hull is designed for longevity and minimal upkeep, and the Yamaha gas propulsion offers broad service support and confident on-water performance. Q: What type of yacht is the STRADIVARI 43? A: It is a motor yacht equipped with a **twin-engine** configuration and a robust **fiberglass and plastic hull** intended for dependable coastal cruising.

pathways and easy operation.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the STRADIVARI 43 from CANTIERI CAPELLI commonly alternate between stylish day trips and short family weekends. The deck layout caters to entertaining: oversized sunpads fore and aft, a convivial U-shaped cockpit, and brochure-listed capacity for up to 18 passengers make it well-suited to hosting and day-charter activity. Down below, four proper berths (a forward double plus a double beneath the cockpit) and a separate head with shower make overnight stays feasible; owners report comfortable headroom, ample natural illumination, considerate finishing touches, and secure movement thanks to broad side decks.

Underway, reviews note strong sea-keeping in moderate conditions and helm ergonomics that provide both protection and clear sightlines beneath the hard-top. Fitted with twin Yamaha XTO outboards and a comprehensive electronics package (joystick control, electronic throttles, autopilot), the boat handles tight maneuvers with composure. Independent test data recorded a

transition to plane near 14.5 knots (roughly 47 l/h) and a best run of 41.6 knots at 5,500 rpm (with testers suggesting around 50 knots could be achievable when pushed), while fuel consumption at top speed was noted at about 267 l/h. Maintenance has been well considered: the surround stern platform improves engine access, ORCA Hypalon 1670 dtex tubes add robustness, and Yamaha's broad dealer network eases routine servicing alongside common systems like Seastar hydraulics, a bow thruster, and shore power. Having premiered in 2021, long-term ownership trends are still emerging.

Pros and Cons

- Very good sea keeping and user-friendly handling with twin Yamaha XTOs and joystick controls.
- Entertaining-focused dayboat arrangement with expansive sunpads, U-shaped cockpit seating, and an 18-passenger rating.
- Weekend-capable accommodations with four berths, comfortable headroom, and a separate toilet and shower.
- Fuel consumption climbs steeply at high speed; tests recorded about 267 l/h at 41.6 kt.
- Interior comforts are optimized for short cruises and weekend use rather than full-time liveaboard life.
- Launched in 2021, so long-term owner feedback and resale patterns remain limited.

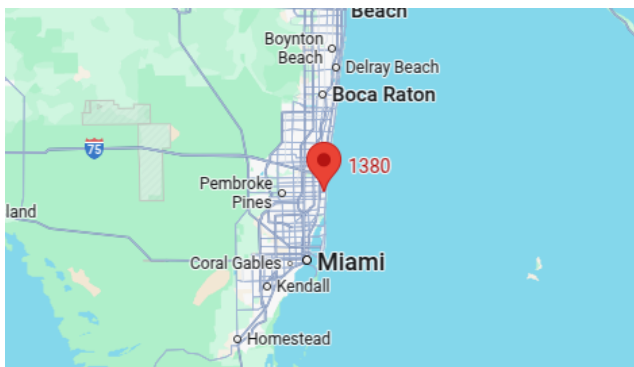
