Selecting a AKHIR 30

Opting for the AKHIR 30 is a smart choice when you prioritize efficient cruising and exhilarating top-speed performance in a refined motor yacht. Its **planing** hull delivers a comfortable 23 knot cruise and a 30 knot top end, while Pier Luigi Spadolini's exterior lines and Studio Arch Tommaso Spadolini's interiors create a unified, elegant onboard environment. Built in fiberglass and plastic, the construction strategy balances robustness with attention to weight. Features of the Model

- Performance DNA: 2 x MTU inboard **diesel** engines produce a 23 knot cruising pace and a 30 knot maximum for confident, speedy passages.
- Design pedigree: Exterior lines by Pier Luigi Spadolini with interior architecture from Studio Arch Tommaso Spadolini ensure stylistic continuity throughout.
- Construction: fiberglass and plastic hull paired with GRP decks for strength, longevity, and simpler upkeep.
- Hull form: **Planing** configuration focused on responsive handling and efficient high speed performance.

- Accommodations: Five heads and three crew cabins configured to support both private ownership and professional, crewed operations.
- Capacity: Generous tankage—3,751.24 gal fuel and 924.6 gal fresh water—extends range and autonomy between port calls.

Q: What type of yacht is the AKHIR 30? A: It's a motor yacht built in fiberglass and plastic by CANTIERI DI PISA, featuring a **planing** hull intended for performance oriented cruising.

Q: How fast does the AKHIR 30 go? A: The **cruising speed** is 23 kn (26.47 mph), and the **maximum speed** is 30 kn (34.52 mph), subject to load, sea state, and other operating conditions.

Q: Who designed the AKHIR 30? A: **Hull designer** : Pier-Luigi Spadolini. **Interior designer** : Studio Arch Tommaso Spadolini.

Q: What powers the AKHIR 30? A: **Engines** : 2 x MTU, **inboard** configuration, **diesel** fuel—providing dependable power and strong performance characteristics.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are attracted to the AKHIR 30 from CANTIERI DI PISA for both family cruising and blended private/charter programs. Typical five cabin arrangements (commonly featuring a full beam master plus several guest cabins), crew quarters accommodating 4–6, and advertised guest capacities of

8–12 make the layout flexible for Mediterranean family voyages and commercial charters. The expansive flybridge—often appointed with a Jacuzzi, sunpads and a bar—is the social heart of the boat, and many vessels have received refits that refresh interiors with a more contemporary, comfortable aesthetic.

On passage, owners and captains report an island hopping profile: regular cruising around 23 knots with peak speeds near 30–31 knots. Listings reference planing or semi displacement GRP hulls, and at least one AKHIR 30 has logged about 360 nm at 17 knots—typical for short range Med operations. Community feedback on similar Akhir models highlights a well sorted helm station, an engine room laid out for access, and a notably large flybridge—practical design details that aid both handling and guest enjoyment.

The compromise is ongoing upkeep. Numerous AKHIR 30 examples have gone through significant refits in recent years, which sets an expectation for periodic, substantive upgrades for boats of this vintage. Common powerplants are MTU 12V 396 TB94 or related 396 variants; while parts and support are widely available, owners and brokers note meaningful service and spare parts expenses. Experienced buyers recommend thorough surveys focused on timber and structural integrity, signs of damp, and detailed engine condition checks prior to purchase.

Pros and Cons

- Five cabin layouts with a full beam master suit family cruising and provide strong charter versatility.
- Typical 23 knot cruising speed and roughly 30–31 knot top speed enable rapid island hopping itineraries.
- Generous flybridge outfitted with Jacuzzi, sunpads and a bar offers excellent entertaining space.

- MTU 396 series powerplants incur notable service and spare parts costs over time.
- Vessels of this age frequently need periodic major refits and system modernizations.
- Construction and interior wood elements require careful survey attention for structural integrity, damp and engine condition.

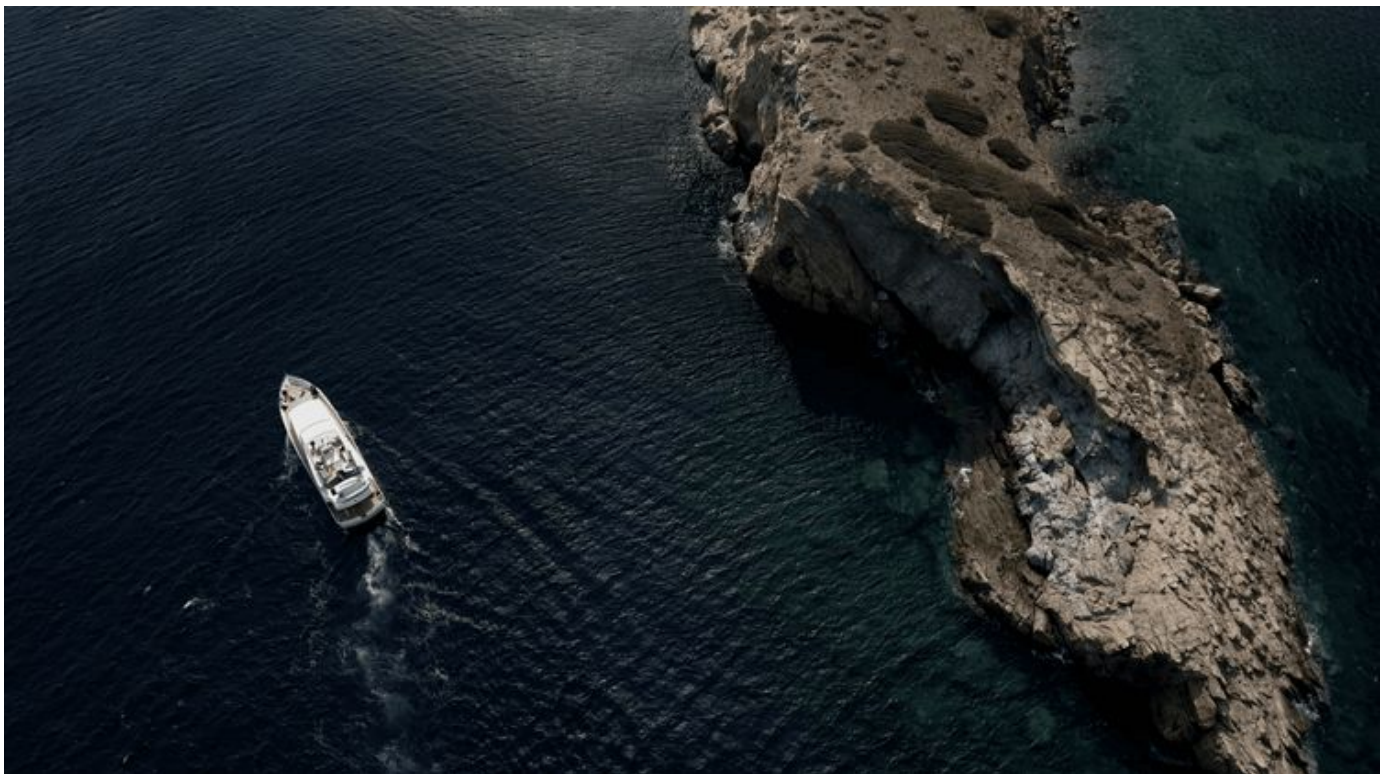
