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## OVERVIEW

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Purpose-built for adaptable day boating, the Center Console from Cape Horn Boats is listed under the motor yachts category and the center console class, built on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull. ## Selecting a Center Console

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Opting for the 23' Center Console is a logical choice if you value straightforward handling with a single Yamaha outboard, an accessible 8' beam, and onboard capacities geared toward day-long outings. Its 3.554' maximum draft accommodates typical nearshore routes and marina berthing, while the fiberglass-and-plastic construction and Fiberglass deck are crafted for durability and simple upkeep. 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## Questions and Answers

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Q: What category does the Center Console belong to? A: It is a motor yacht in the center console class segment, ideal for versatile day boating.

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: The boat is equipped with a single Yamaha **engine** that is **Outboard** and runs on **Gas**, emphasizing simplicity and serviceability.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** is 23 ft (7.01 m), the **beam** is 8 ft

(2.54 m), and the maximum **draft** is 3.554 ft (1.0833 m).

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 75 gal and **water capacity** is 35 gal, well-suited for full-day outings.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The hull is categorized as fiberglass and plastic, and the **deck** is Fiberglass, delivering a durable, easy-care platform.

## Owner Experience Review

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Buyers often select the Center Console from Cape Horn Boats for dedicated fishing and offshore day trips, while others use them for bay runs, inshore work, and occasional canyon passages. Independent sea trials of the 27 XS noted an exceptionally dry ride with reports of “zero saltwater hit the deck,” and many owners describe these boats as solid and stable in challenging conditions. Foam filled hull voids are commonly credited with reducing noise, increasing hull stiffness, and adding reserve buoyancy that contributes to unsinkability. As verification of performance, a professional sea trial of the 27 XS recorded roughly 38 mph at about 4500 rpm, around 55 mph at wide open throttle, and the boat could plane and maintain speeds above 20 mph on a single engine.

Aboard, the layout prioritizes fishing: generous livewells and oversized fishboxes receive consistent praise from anglers. Creature comforts are intentionally minimal from the factory; test boats called out a compact console head and the absence of helm AC or a grill, with interiors characterized as utilitarian rather than luxurious. Owners of the smaller variants sometimes comment that factory seating is not particularly comfortable and that storage space can feel constrained.

Long term owners advise thorough inspections on older hulls. Several reports

note that pre 2002 constructions incorporated some wood, so floors and transoms should be checked for rot. Earlier models also used plastic compartment hatches that may deteriorate and require replacement. Used listings occasionally mention poly fuel tank concerns and moisture issues stemming from water ingress through deck plates and trapped moisture in foam; repowers are common on aging examples, and complete maintenance records are highly valued.

## Pros and Cons

- Dry and confident rough water behavior, with testing of the 27 XS noting zero spray on deck.
- Foam filled hull voids deliver a quieter, stiffer ride and provide reserve buoyancy/unsinkability.
- Fishing first deck plan with large livewells and oversized fishboxes.
- Family amenities are limited from the factory, with a small console head and no helm AC or grill on test boats.
- Some owners of smaller models report less comfortable seating and limited storage.
- Older boats warrant inspection for pre 2002 wood construction and possible poly fuel tank/moisture issues.

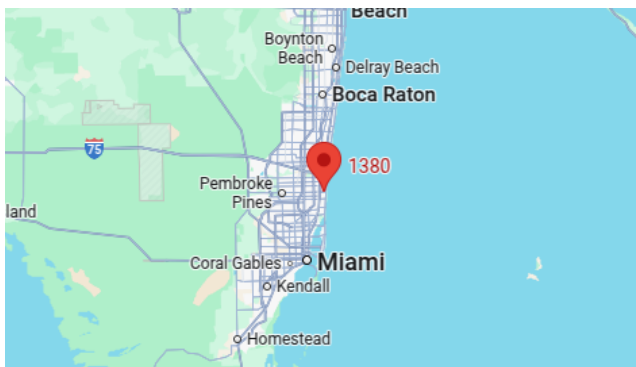
