The 281HB Center Console from CAYMAS is a multi purpose center-console motor yacht built on a confidence instilling fiberglass hull. Offered by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this design pairs twin Mercury outboard power with sensible tankage and a compact head inside a nimble, trailerable footprint.

As a center-console motor yacht from CAYMAS, it delivers straightforward handling for day trips while providing the convenience of twin Mercury engines and an onboard head.

Q: What is the **type** of the 281HB Center Console? A: It is a center-console motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass hull.

Q: What **engines** power this model? A: Twin **Mercury outboard** engines (2 total) running on **gas** supply propulsion and straightforward serviceability.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** ? A: The **LOA** measures 27 ft (8.51 m), the **beam** is 9 ft (2.84 m), and the minimum **draft** is 4.374 ft (1.3333 m).

Q: What onboard **amenities** and **capacities** are included? A: The boat includes 1 **head** , a **fuel capacity** of 200 gal, and an **8 gal** freshwater capacity.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers characterize the 281HB Center Console by CAYMAS as a true hybrid craft: it will slip into shallow bays with about a 16 inch draft when the engines are trimmed up, yet it maintains the seaworthiness and fuel range to venture offshore. The Michael Peters Stepped Vee Ventilated Tunnel hull earns frequent praise for delivering a very dry, "butter soft" ride and notably efficient fuel consumption; handling at cruise is described as steady when the boat is properly powered. Within the factory's stated twin outboard envelope (up to 600 hp), many owners find dual 250s provide a well balanced package.

On deck, the layout suits both anglers and families: generous nonskid casting areas, roomy storage lockers, and integrated livewells complement U shaped bow seating, centerline flip up seats, and available options like a porcelain head and freshwater tank. Early owner feedback trends positive—comments include "loving the boat" and "would buy again"—and the model has also been used in charter operations around the Florida Keys. Practical owner notes from forums mention trailer behavior such as tail wagging and occasional hub/spindle concerns, so owners commonly verify hitch height, tire pressures, and trailer hardware. Factory materials note a lifetime limited hull warranty for the original owner along with multi year coverage for various components.

Pros and Cons

- Hybrid versatility for inshore and offshore use, with approximately 16 in draft for shallow water operation.
- Dry, comfortable, and fuel efficient ride attributed to the Michael Peters SVT hull.
- A fish and family oriented deckplan featuring casting areas, abundant storage/livewells, bow seating, and optional head/freshwater systems.
- Owner reports of trailer tail wagging and hub/spindle issues mean careful trailer setup and regular inspections are advised.
- Best handling performance depends on correct engine selection and setup; many owners prefer twin 250s within the 600 hp limit.
- Lifetime limited hull warranty applies to the original owner.
