Q: What type of boat is the 2001 Center Console? A: It is a motor yacht built with a genuine center-console layout by CENTURY BOATS for versatile dayboating.

Q: What is the engine setup and fuel? A: The vessel is powered by a single Yamaha [[**Engine**]] configured as an [[**Outboard**]] and fueled by [[**Gas**]].

Q: How shallow can it operate? A: The minimum [[**Draft**]] is 3.554 ft (1.0833 m), which allows operation in shallow bays and nearshore areas.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The [[**Hull**]] is constructed from fiberglass and plastic in a Modified Deep Vee form, while the [[**Deck**]] is Fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers of the 2001 Center Console from CENTURY BOATS generally describe it as a multipurpose platform that balances family outings with serious fishing capability. Typical cruising grounds include inshore bays, lakes, and coastal passages, and many owners will take it offshore when conditions permit. The deck arrangement, optional hardtop choices, and comfortable helm seating packages are often praised for being family friendly while maintaining practical angling features such as dedicated rod storage, numerous rod holders, and adequately sized livewells.

Reported on water behavior from brand tests of like sized Century center consoles (including models such as the 2901) highlights steady tracking in 2–3 ft chop, brisk planing, and a trim tab system that responds with just a light touch. Ride comfort varies by hull generation and fitout; owners note that pre 2001 hulls could run a bit “wet” in chop, with subsequent redesigns improving ride characteristics—so expectations should match each boat’s specific configuration and condition.

Maintenance feedback is varied but consistent on several points. Older Century models sometimes required transom or stringer work, whereas later adoption of foam/urethane transom modules reduced decay risk. Access to systems such as bilge pumps and the fuel tank can be confined and may complicate routine servicing. The brand's frequent pairing with Yamaha four stroke outboards means owners should plan for standard outboard maintenance and, over long ownership horizons, consider the possibility of a repower. Publicly available, model specific owner data for the 2001 Center Console is limited; the points above reflect typical observations for Century center consoles of comparable size and era.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile layout suitable for family day trips, weekend escapes, and serious fishing.
- Strong fishability with generous rod and tackle storage, multiple rod holders, and adequate livewell capacity.
- In brand testing, maintains good tracking in moderate chop and reacts swiftly to trim tab adjustments.
- Access to bilge pumps and the fuel tank can be tight, making maintenance more difficult.
- Some older Centurys have required transom or stringer repairs; later foam/urethane transoms reduce rot vulnerability.
- Effective use of trim tabs is necessary to optimize ride; the hull generation influences how dry the ride feels.
