## OVERVIEW

---

The 3200 Center Console by CENTURY BOATS is a flexible center console yacht positioned in the wider motor yacht class. Its fiberglass and plastic construction on a Deep Vee hull delivers a confident handling character and lively on-water performance, while twin Yamaha outboards propel the design to speeds as high as 50 knots.

## Selecting a 3200 Center Console

---

Opting for the 3200 Center Console is a smart choice if you prize the open-deck practicality and nimble handling of a center console platform combined with the capabilities expected in the motor yacht segment. At 32 feet with a 10-foot beam, it presents a stable footprint and a Deep Vee profile that slices through chop. The twin Yamaha outboards give straightforward, punchy propulsion. With a 280-gallon fuel tank and 30 gallons of freshwater aboard, the boat is designed for extended days offshore, and a single head plus a berth for one accommodate occasional overnight trips.

- Performance-focused setup with twin Yamaha outboards and a top speed up to 50 kn (about 50 mph)
- Deep Vee hull for composed ride and tracking
- fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck for durability and easy upkeep
- Practical comfort with 1 head and sleeping for 1
- Dimensions that balance room and maneuverability: 32 ft LOA, 10 ft beam
- Gas outboard propulsion for straightforward maintenance and responsive throttle

## Questions and Answers

---

- What type of yacht is the 3200 Center Console? The boat is a center console yacht within the motor yachts category, built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a Deep Vee configuration for **type** , **category** , and **hull** clarity.
- How fast can it go and what powers it? The **max speed** reaches up to 50 kn (roughly 50 mph), achieved with **twin Yamaha outboards** (2 x Yamaha, **Gas Outboard** engines).
- What are the key dimensions and draft? **LOA** measures 32 ft (9.75 m), **beam** is 10 ft (3.2 m), and **draft (min)** is 5.468 ft (1.6666 m).
- What onboard amenities are included? Accommodation includes **1 head** , **sleeps 1** , and a **water capacity** of 30 gal for modest overnight needs.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners often select the 3200 Center Console from CENTURY BOATS for its dual-purpose nature. The boat combines serious angling features—large insulated fishboxes, a tournament-sized 62-gallon livewell, and plentiful rod stowage—with a family-oriented forward “Social Center” that includes a U-shaped lounge, a removable bow table, and protection from the sun provided by the hardtop. Its roughly 280-gallon fuel capacity makes extended offshore passages and weekend runs practical.

On the water, many owners describe a sturdy, “built like a tank” sensation and a generally dry ride at cruising speeds. In short, steep Gulf chop some operators report a pounding motion; careful selection of props and attentive use of trim tabs reduce that effect considerably. Test reports and owner

feedback cite about a 28 mph cruise and a roughly 51 mph top end with twin 350s on the redesigned model, while other engine combinations commonly yield practical cruising in the 30–40+ mph range. The hull reacts predictably to tab and trim adjustments and remains steady at rest—qualities appreciated by anglers when fishing or staging.

Day long comfort is supported by a console cabin with over six feet of headroom, an enclosed electric head, and a single sleeping berth, along with plentiful storage spaces. The paired 277 quart fishboxes, extensive rod lockers, and electrically adjustable helm seating plus configurable aft seating are frequently praised for their ergonomic layout and tidy utility. On the maintenance side, owner forums and technician anecdotes mention occasional listing to port, spider cracking on older compartment lids, and isolated reports of power head failures related to cavitation under certain conditions; prospective buyers are advised to commission thorough surveys and pay careful attention to engine installation and prop selection.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Tournament ready fishing setup with large insulated fishboxes, a 62 gallon livewell, and abundant rod storage.
- Family friendly forward lounge with a removable table and shaded hardtop supports easy entertaining.
- Solid, dry feel at moderate speeds, good stability at rest, and long range from ~280 gallons of fuel.
- Can feel pouncy in short, steep Gulf chop if props, trim, and tabs are not dialed in.
- Reports of port side listing and spider cracks on older boats call for close inspection.
- Anecdotal power head failures linked to cavitation suggest careful attention to engine installation and propping.
