The Arabian from CENTURY BOATS is a compact motor yacht that combines a 19 ft (5.92 m) LOA and an 8 ft (2.44 m) beam with a single Ford inboard gasoline engine. Designed for brisk outings, it cruises at 25 knots and can reach 40 knots, supported by a 30-gallon fuel tank for efficient day use. Picking the right craft is important. If your priority is a nimble day boat with simple propulsion, the Arabian built by CENTURY BOATS strikes a practical balance between size and speed: a comfortable 25-knot cruise and the ability to push to 40 knots when necessary. Measuring 19 ft overall with an 8 ft beam, it's easy to maneuver yet offers the essentials for enjoyable outings.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the speeds of the Arabian? A: The **cruise speed** is 25 kn (28.77 mph) and the **top speed** is 40 kn (46.03 mph).

Q: What powers the yacht? A: A single Ford inboard running on gas. This **engine** configuration emphasizes simplicity and responsive handling.

Q: What are the dimensions? A: **LOA** is 19 ft (5.92 m) and **beam** is 8 ft (2.44 m), giving the Arabian a compact footprint.

Q: How much fuel does it carry and how many heads are onboard? A: **Fuel**

**capacity** is 30 gallons, and there are **heads** : 5.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly use the Arabian by CENTURY BOATS as a family weekend boat and a watersports platform. The traditional 19' arrangement with bench seating and an aft sun lounge provides comfortable day-cruising accommodations, and many examples include a swim platform for easy water access. Beyond recreation and towing duties, the model enjoys popularity on the classic-boat circuit; restored boats frequently appear at antique and classic events and have earned first-place honors.

It is also frequently purchased as a restoration or repower candidate, with many owners swapping in modern V8s such as crate LT1s. On the water, proprietors praise the hull for offering a versatile, sure-footed ride with lively, predictable handling for a vintage runabout. While not designed as a contemporary high-speed craft, fitted with substantial V8 power the Arabian produces robust mid-range performance suitable for family recreation and pulling skiers.

Owners note that older wooden builds can be sensitive to rigging and how weight is distributed; weakened floors or stringers will alter trim and handling in noticeable ways. Comfort is focused on day use: bench seating, an aft sun lounge, and limited locker capacity serve short excursions well, but there is no true liveboard space or standing headroom. After thorough restorations, buyers frequently commend renewed upholstery and authentic period color schemes that boost both functionality and show appeal. Maintenance requirements vary by hull condition: wooden “soak bottom” boats may

demand regular varnishing and refastening, and in some cases new ribs or bottom repairs; complete restoration or servicing can represent a major investment.

## Pros and Cons

- Confident, responsive handling for a vintage runabout with a satisfying, adaptable ride.
- Versatile day boat layout with bench seating and an aft sun lounge, with many 19' examples adding a swim platform.
- Strong enthusiast/collector appeal; restored boats are frequently shown and can win awards.
- Older wooden hulls demand ongoing varnish/refastening and can drive substantial restoration scope and cost.
- Stringer and floor deterioration is a known issue on aging boats and can noticeably affect trim and handling.
- Limited storage and no real cabin headroom make it best suited to day outings rather than overnighting.
