OVERVIEW

The 44 Power from CERVETTI is a flexible motor yacht catamaran built in the fiberglass and plastic category and is listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov representing the model.

Selecting a 44 Power

Opt for the 44 Power if you want a 44 ft (13.41 m) platform paired with a wide 32 ft (9.75 m) beam, a single engine layout that you can tailor, and substantial tank capacities. As a motor yacht catamaran in the fiberglass and plastic segment, it balances a compact footprint with operational efficiency and onboard volume.

Features of the Model

- Category and format: a motor yacht catamaran designed for diverse coastal missions and extended cruising programs.
- Construction: the hull is built in the fiberglass and plastic family; the deck is finished in Fiberglass.
- Power choice: single engine arrangement; manufacturer **is to be selected by the buyer** .
- Capacities: fuel 475.51 gal; fresh water 182.28 gal.
- Dimensions: **LOA** 44 ft (13.41 m); **beam** 32 ft (9.75 m).

Q: What type of yacht is the 44 Power? A: It is a motor yacht catamaran in the fiberglass and plastic category, constructed by CERVETTI. This clarifies the yacht's **classification** and structural approach.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The **LOA** measures 44 ft (13.41 m) while the **beam** spans 32 ft (9.75 m), creating a roomy platform that supports versatile interior and cockpit arrangements.

Q: What engine options are available? A: The 44 Power is specified with a **single engine** (engine count: 1). The **engine manufacturer** is to be selected by the buyer, giving you freedom to choose brand and service network preferences.

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 475.51 gallons and **water capacity** is 182.28 gallons, which supports varied cruising ranges and onboard autonomy.

Owner Experience Review

Charter companies, family owners, and share fleet operators have been deploying the 44 Power by CERVETTI for day excursions and week long itineraries. Feedback from those operators highlights the model's adaptability for both private use and commercial charters.

On the water it's frequently described as a stable, spacious power cat well suited to island hopping; the shallow 1.10 m draft lets skippers reach secluded coves and reef lined anchorages that many monohulls must avoid. Charter listings note it is "very pleasant to handle for a week cruise or longer," and professional reviews underscore a focus on comfortable, efficient cruising rather than outright planing speeds, citing a practical 1,800 L fuel capacity.

Aboard, social spaces receive high praise. Users regularly call out the flybridge and expansive cockpit as the primary social hubs, complemented by an oversized sunpad, integrated fridge/wet bar, and a cockpit plancha barbecue. The L shaped galley is fully equipped for entertaining, and the accommodation options (3 or 4 cabins plus skipper, 3-4 heads) with 200×160 cm beds suit family groups or small charter parties; some operators advertise up to 8-9 berths. One guest summed up the experience: "The boat was amazing and the crew were just fabulous."

From an ownership and maintenance standpoint, CERVETTI literature

highlights large engine room hatches and removable floor panels for easier access during servicing. Note that published engine specifications vary across sources (some listings report 2×270 hp Volvo units, while the manufacturer PDF references a 2×320 hp Toyota V8 base), so prospective buyers and fleet managers should confirm the exact propulsion fitment for spares and service planning. No systemic mechanical failure trends have emerged in owner forums, but the model is still relatively new in private and charter use, so long term durability data are limited.

Pros and Cons

- Stable, comfortable handling well suited to island hopping and week long cruises.
- Shallow 1.10 m draft grants access to sheltered coves and reef fringed anchorages.
- Flybridge plus a generous cockpit with sunbathing platform, wet bar, and plancha barbecue create excellent entertaining spaces.
- Not intended for high speed planing; the design favors comfort and fuel efficiency over top end speed.
- Published engine specifications are inconsistent across listings, so buyers should verify the exact propulsion for parts and maintenance planning.
- Long term reliability figures are scarce because the model is a recent addition to owner and charter fleets.
