OVERVIEW

The 41 Nighthawk from Cigarette Racing is a motor yacht with a hull built in fiberglass and plastic and powered by four Mercury gas engines. Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 41 Nighthawk

Opting for the 41 Nighthawk gives you a balanced high-performance platform with a 41 ft (12.5 m) length overall and an 11 ft (3.35 m) beam that blends cockpit space with sporty handling. Its draft, which spans 6.562–9.296 ft (2–2.8333 m), accommodates varied cruising conditions, and a single onboard head adds convenience for day use. With a 350-gallon fuel capacity and 25 gallons of fresh water, the design supports longer days on the water within this size class. Questions and Answers

Q: What are the LOA and beam of the 41 Nighthawk? A: The **LOA** is 41 ft (12.5 m) and the **beam** is 11 ft (3.35 m), giving a purposeful footprint for a motor yacht.

Q: How many engines does it have and what fuel do they use? A: The model is fitted with **4 engines** from **Mercury** operating on **Gas/Petrol** , delivering dependable propulsion for this platform.

Q: What is the draft range? A: The **draft** spans from a **minimum** of 6.562 ft (2 m) to a **maximum** of 9.296 ft (2.8333 m).

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 350 gallons, and **water capacity** is 25 gallons, supporting extended day runs and flexible outing plans.

Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: The **hull** is constructed in fiberglass and plastic, while the **deck** is Fiberglass, reflecting sturdy composite construction.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly deploy the 41 Nighthawk as a high-speed center-console dayboat for inland lakes and coastal runs—places such as Lake of the Ozarks and Fort Lauderdale—and as a support or chase craft during race weekends. It frequently appears at poker runs and social performance gatherings.

On-the-water reports describe a craft that turns sharply and can cruise comfortably around 80 mph with eight people aboard, with typical top speeds near 84 mph. Special AMG Black Series versions fitted with five Mercury Racing V8s have been recorded above 90 mph in media test runs, demonstrating the design's extreme potential.

Finish and onboard comfort draw regular acclaim. One owner termed the boat "a work of art," praising its exceptional fit and finish. Amenities tailored to dayboat use—dual-row power helm seating, Cigarette Racing Cool Touch upholstery, air conditioning, soft-deck flooring, and roomy cockpit seating—make fast runs more comfortable, and owners frequently note the hull retains composure while carrying a full complement at speed.

Practical ownership considerations reflect the multi-outboard configuration. Quad-engine setups, and particularly the five-engine AMG specials, increase

parts inventories and service demands; press coverage cites race-grade engines costing in the high tens of thousands per unit. Online owner forums for high-performance outboards have documented problems with Mercury Racing 450R units (issues with lower units, actuators, belts, and supercharger seals), which can complicate ownership when faults appear. The benefit is straightforward external access to the motors, but more engines equates to more routine maintenance, and many owners depend on dealer concierge services and warranty coverage for support.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Nimble handling that turns on a dime and sustains around 80 mph even with eight people aboard.
- Pro: High-end fit and finish with dayboat comforts like dual-row power helm seating, Cool Touch upholstery, air conditioning, and soft-deck flooring.
- Pro: Versatile use case—from lake and coastal dayboating to poker runs and offshore race support.
- Con: Multiple outboards increase service complexity and cost, especially on quad and five-engine builds.
- Con: Owners have reported Mercury Racing 450R issues on some boats, including lower units and supercharger-related components.
- Con: The AMG five-engine special editions push speed but add significant parts count and race-engine expenses.
