OVERVIEW

The 42 Auroris from Cigarette Racing is a purpose-built motor yacht engineered for high-performance cruising. Built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and propelled by five Mercury outboards, it delivers a concentrated blend of size, power, and construction quality. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 42 Auroris targets buyers seeking spirited performance in a refined package.

Selecting a 42 Auroris

Choosing the 42 Auroris places you in a high-performance platform from Cigarette Racing. At 42 ft (12.8 m) overall and an 11 ft (3.63 m) beam, the boat presents assertive proportions and a purposeful on-water posture. Its motor yacht lines, together with a fiberglass and plastic build, emphasize durability while prioritizing speed and weight efficiency. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 42 Auroris? A: It is a motor yacht built for high-performance applications on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Standout attributes include **performance intent** , **durable construction** , and a **fiberglass deck** .

Q: What powers the model? A: A quintet of **Mercury outboard** engines

running on **Gas/Petrol** supply the propulsion, creating the 42 Auroris's sharp performance character.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: **LOA** measures 42 ft (12.8 m) while **Beam** is 11 ft (3.63 m), which together define the boat's footprint and stability envelope.

Q: What is the draft range? A: **Draft** spans from a minimum of 6.562 ft (2 m) up to a maximum of 9.296 ft (2.8333 m), accommodating varied operating conditions.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically report two distinct use cases for the 42 Auroris: relaxed family days on the water and spirited social or performance outings. New owners Jason and Lisa Hill praised the deep cockpit for both comfort and safety when boating with their youngest child aboard. Common owner layouts revealed in listings include a forward lounge that converts into a berth, an enclosed head, and a powered table that drops to form an additional sleeping surface. Dealer and owner examples often list extras such as an air-conditioned cabin, a helm-mounted video feed for monitoring children, a Garmin-forward helm package, JL Audio sound systems, and ambient lighting.

On the water, reviewers and owners consistently describe confident, stable handling derived from Cigarette Racing's twin-step hull and the wider beam. Typical cruising speeds are reported around 60 mph, with top-end figures into the low 80s depending on engine and propeller choices, and the large fuel

tanks (commonly noted as roughly 470–500 gallons in listings) support extended high-speed runs between refueling. Magazine evaluations of quad-500R configurations also note steady behavior at speed. That said, forum discussions have flagged some center-console fit-and-finish details and a few paint schemes as less than ideal, so it's prudent to set cosmetic expectations and inspect finishes carefully during purchase.

Pros and Cons

- Confident, stable handling from Cigarette Racing's twin-step hull, including stability at elevated speeds.
- Family-oriented ergonomics such as a deep cockpit, enclosed head, and a versatile lounge that converts into a berth.
- Substantial fuel capacity (about 470–500 gallons as noted in listings) enables longer high-speed passages between fuel stops.
- Quad or quint Mercury Racing outboards add complexity to routine servicing and raise scheduled maintenance costs.
- Owner forums have documented specific 450R/500R concerns (oil leaks and fuel-pressure/alarm issues), suggesting some examples may require warranty or technical support.
- Some owners criticize center-console details and certain factory paint schemes, so finish quality can vary and should be reviewed during inspection.

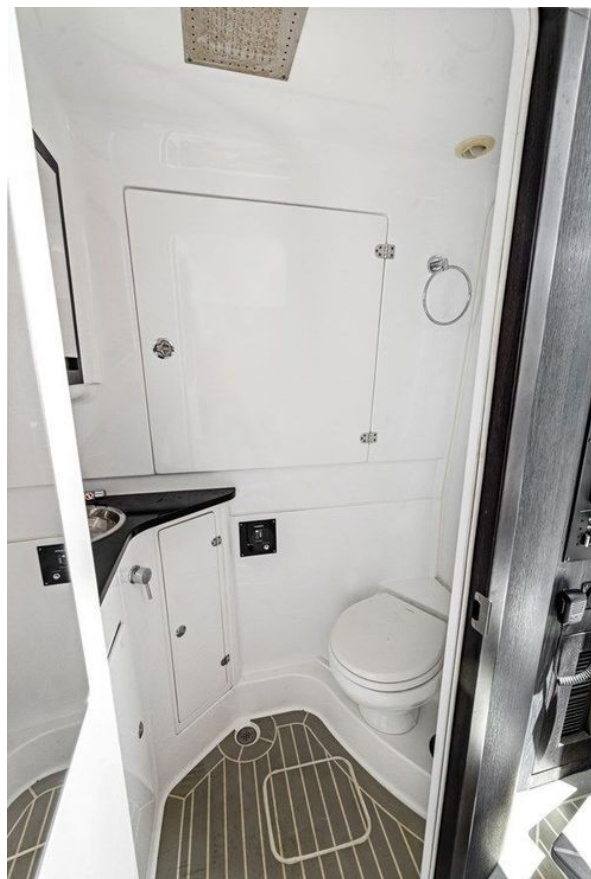
