OVERVIEW

The Custom 17m from COASTAL CRAFT is a motor yacht built on an aluminum yacht hull with a Deep Vee hull form. Propulsion comes from four Mercury gas outboards, and the vessel measures 55 ft overall with a 14 ft beam. Selecting a Custom 17m

Opting for the Custom 17m is sensible if you prioritize a contemporary layout driven by a quartet of Mercury gas outboards and the resilience of an aluminum hull with a Deep Vee running surface. In the context of the motor yachts market, this 17 m vessel strikes a balance between overall length and a 4.27 m beam to create ample deck space and a functional interior that includes one head.

Features of the Model

- Durable aluminum construction featuring an aluminum yacht hull designed for long-term serviceability and straightforward upkeep.
- Deep Vee hull geometry tuned to provide confidence and predictable behavior across a range of sea states.
- Quad Mercury gas outboards offer strong, responsive propulsion while keeping engine access and servicing simpler than inboard alternatives.
- Overall dimensions of 55 ft LOA and a 14 ft beam yield generous usable deck areas and maximized internal volume for this size class.
- A single head layout supports uncomplicated owner operator use and weekend cruising.
- Aluminum deck construction complements the hull's robustness while

reducing long-term maintenance needs.

- Presented as a flexible motor yacht within the broader segment of motor yachts.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the Custom 17m? A: The boat's **LOA** is 55 ft (17 m) and the **beam** is 14 ft (4.27 m).

Q: What engines power this model? A: It is equipped with four **Mercury Outboard** engines running on **Gas** for service-friendly access and lively

performance.

Q: What are the hull form and material? A: The hull is a **Deep Vee** built as an **aluminum** structure, classified under aluminum yacht.

Q: How much fuel does it carry? A: **Fuel capacity** is 792.52 gallons, allowing for extended cruising ranges between refueling stops.

Q: Who can help me purchase this yacht? A: Your **Broker** is Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales. The **Builder** is COASTAL CRAFT, and the model is a motor yacht suitable for buyers evaluating motor yachts.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the Custom 17m from COASTAL CRAFT for a combination of sportfishing capability and relaxed family coastal cruising. In the “Starfish I” specification it’s presented as an owner operator weekend motoryacht with a single stateroom arrangement. Manufacturer notes and real world testing of larger Coastal Craft models emphasize the deep V aluminum hull and the quad outboard planing configuration that reaches plane efficiently, produces a solid and comfortable feel, and maintains a relatively dry ride in moderate chop.

Aboard, professional reviewers of Coastal Craft designs frequently highlight the quality of fit and finish plus thoughtful ergonomics, noting plentiful storage, well considered galley placement, and comfortable helm and dinette layouts. The 1 stateroom/1 head floorplan positions the Custom 17m for small party overnight cruising rather than hosting large groups. It’s important to recognize that many of the handling and interior observations cited here are drawn from brand literature and sea trials of larger Coastal Craft models rather than extended owner logs specific to this bespoke 17 m build.

Maintenance considerations are significant: the “Starfish I” specification calls

for four 600 hp Mercury V12 outboards, a package that concentrates high performance but increases service and parts complexity. Reviews of larger Coastal Craft vessels report accessible service areas and components placed for straightforward routine maintenance, which is encouraging for ongoing upkeep. Prospective buyers should also weigh a practical caveat: the manufacturer entered receivership in January 2026, and community reports have raised questions regarding continued factory support, so after sales arrangements deserve careful review.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V aluminum hull paired with a quad outboard planing arrangement delivers a dry, stable ride through moderate chop.
- Interior finish and ergonomics across Coastal Craft models receive strong praise, with efficient galley locations and comfortable helm/dinette setups.
- The owner operator 1 stateroom/1 head configuration is well suited for weekend getaways and small party overnighting.
- Four 600 hp Mercury V12 outboards create maintenance and parts complexity that owners should plan for.
- The manufacturer’s January 2026 receivership introduces uncertainty about long term factory support and continuity.
- A limited number of cabins constrains the yacht’s ability to host larger guest groups or operate as a charter platform.
