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## OVERVIEW

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Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 272 from COBALT is a compact, capable motor yacht built on a dependable fiberglass and plastic platform, offering a blend of spirited open-water performance and comfortable day-boat amenities.

## Selecting a 272

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Opting for the 272 emphasizes practicality and ease of use. Measuring 27 ft (8.23 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, it's sized for straightforward handling and simple slip management. The single Mercruiser I/O gas propulsion, integrated head, and modest fuel and water tanks make it an uncomplicated choice for day cruising. ## Questions and Answers

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Q: What are the key dimensions of the 272? A: The 272 is a motor yacht with an LOA of **27 ft (8.23 m)** , a **beam** of **8 ft (2.59 m)** , and a **draft** ranging from **6.015 ft (1.8333 m)** to **10.663 ft (3.25 m)** , built on a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What is the engine configuration? A: It is equipped with a single **engine** by **Mercruiser** , configured as an **I/O** drive running on **Gas** , which keeps operation and servicing straightforward.

Q: What onboard capacities does it have? A: The 272 carries a **fuel capacity** of **70 gal** and a **water capacity** of **10 gal** , adequate for routine day trips.

Q: Does the 272 include a head and what are the materials? A: Yes—there is **1 head** aboard. The **deck** is constructed of Fiberglass, and the **hull** is listed as fiberglass and plastic.

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners frequently praise the 272 by COBALT as a flexible day-boat that “offers everything a family needs,” handling family outings, entertaining, and quick weekend jaunts with ease. The cockpit layout is often highlighted for its spaciousness: six-person bow seating, a 6 ft aft settee, and a fold-down port bench create versatile sociable spaces, while the wet bar with a Corian surface and the expansive swim platform encourage gathering and watersports.

Many owners use the 272 for skiing and towing, thanks to the built-in ski-tow and the model’s quick planing ability; the small cuddy cabin with a porta-potty adds useful practicality for daylong trips. In hands-on testing, reviewers noted the hull “sliced cleanly forward” through chop and reported the ride felt “secure in the comfortable ride” when conditions were unsettled. A published trial of a 375 hp 496 MAG installation recorded a comfortable cruise near 25.9 mph at 2500 rpm and a top speed close to 52.2 mph, figures that match owner

reports of towing and spirited transits. The sunpad that doubles as an electrically actuated engine hatch, assisted by gas rams, is frequently mentioned as a convenient design detail that eases maintenance access.

From the maintenance side, resale listings and forums commonly list risers, manifolds, bellows, and temperature sensors among repeat service items, and several owners discuss experimenting with propeller pitch—sometimes purchasing new props to refine performance. The owner’s manual cautions that incorrect propeller selection can negatively affect handling, and owners often cite replacing spark plugs every other year as routine maintenance. These notes are drawn from listings and owner discussions; actual service history varies by individual boat and upkeep.

## Pros and Cons

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- Roomy cockpit arrangement with six-person bow seating, a 6 ft aft settee, and a fold-down port bench that supports family entertaining.
- Confident sea manners, with a hull that “sliced cleanly forward” and was described as “secure in the comfortable ride.”
- Tested 375 hp 496 MAG setup delivered ~25.9 mph cruise at 2500 rpm and ~52.2 mph top end.
- Recurring service items on resale examples include risers, manifolds, bellows, and temperature sensors.
- Propeller selection can be finicky, with owner-reported pitch tradeoffs and a manual warning about adverse handling.
- Routine ignition upkeep like replacing spark plugs every other year is commonly cited by owners.
