With an overall length of 45 ft (13.72 m) and a single Perkins engine, the design focuses on straightforward, dependable systems suited to cruising. Owner Experience Review

Owners who select the 45 from CORONADO YACHTS frequently praise it as a comfortable liveaboard and a dependable cruising platform. Several reports note extended liveaboard use made possible by a center cockpit design that delivers a private, full width aft master cabin, a generous salon, ample headroom, and a galley with true residential proportions. Typical layouts provide two staterooms and plentiful storage, making it well suited for family coastal cruises and capable of longer passages.

When underway, the 45 exhibits the steady, heavy displacement character expected for bluewater work; owners commonly describe its motion as “stiff and track straight.” It handles reaches with stability and is predictable in rough seas, though performance in very light winds is modest and typical hull speed is in the 7.8–7.9 knot range. Higher freeboard and windage can complicate docking in crosswinds. Experienced owners also highlight typical inspection priorities on older boats: potential deck core moisture near penetrations, the condition of chainplates and their fastenings, rudder bearing wear or play, and the difficulty of replacing fuel and water tanks when necessary.

Pros and Cons

- Heavy displacement stability and consistent offshore manners ideal for bluewater passages.
- Generous interior with center cockpit privacy, a full width aft cabin, notable headroom, and a galley suited to liveaboard needs.
- Well matched to liveaboard lifestyles and family coastal cruising.
- Limited light air performance; normal hull speed about 7.8–7.9 knots.

- Elevated freeboard and resultant windage can make close quarters docking in crosswinds challenging.
- Older vessels may require significant maintenance: deck core moisture issues, chainplate inspection/repair, rudder bearing service, and potentially difficult replacement of fuel and water tanks.

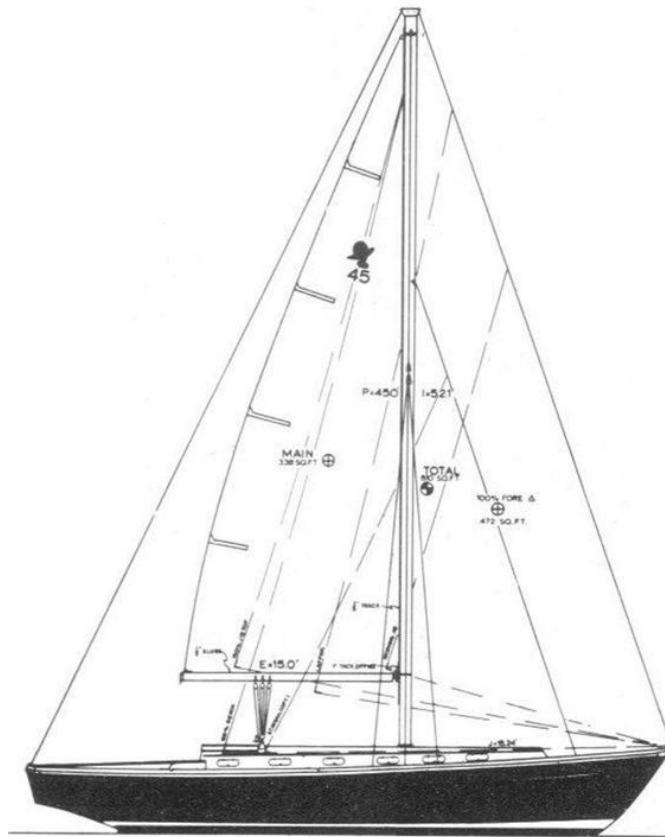

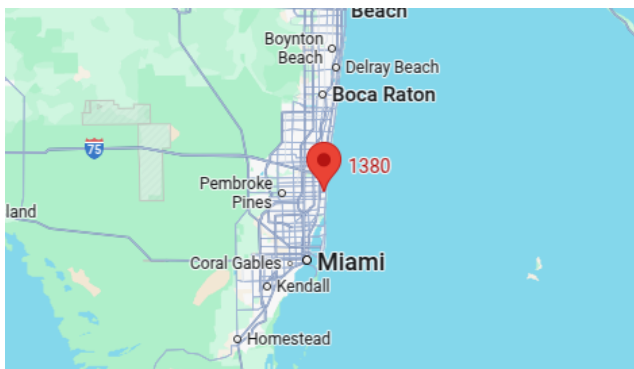
