The Daniels Boatworks 42 Express by CUSTOM CAROLINA combines the hard-driving attributes anglers demand with the refinement owners expect in a compact motor yacht tailored to the sport fisherman role. Built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull with a Steve French planing form, twin Cummins engines, and a practical two-person accommodation plan, it balances quick offshore capability, efficient cruising, and onboard comfort. ## Selecting a Daniels Boatworks 42 Express

---

Opt for the Daniels Boatworks 42 Express if you prioritize a nimble, fuel-efficient planing hull that doubles as a purposeful fish-and-cruise platform. With a typical cruise of 30 kn (34.52 mph) and a top end near 38 kn (43.73 mph), it answers the needs of anglers who want quick runs offshore as well as owners looking for spirited coastal passages. The interior layout supports two overnight guests with a single head, and a 550-gallon fuel reserve extends range for long days away from port. As a compact motor yacht in the sport fisherman segment, it's aimed at buyers focused on performance and practical cruising.

## Questions and Answers

---

- Q: What is the performance of the Daniels Boatworks 42 Express? A: Its **cruising speed** is 30 kn (34.52 mph) and the **top speed** reaches 38 kn (43.73 mph).
- Q: Who builds and designs this model? A: The **builder** is CUSTOM CAROLINA, with **hull design** by Steve French and **interior design** by Kurt Daniels.
- Q: What are the hull and deck details? A: It uses a **planing** hull in fiberglass and plastic with a **Composite** deck for strength and durability.
- Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: **LOA** is 42 ft (12.8 m), **beam** is 14 ft (4.32 m), and **draft** is 13.123 ft (4 m) minimum/maximum.
- Q: How is it powered and how many can stay aboard? A: Power comes from **2 Cummins** engines; **accommodations** are for 2 people with **1 head**, and **fuel capacity** is 550 gal.

## Owner Experience Review

---

As an express-style sportfisher, broker listings for the Daniels Boatworks 42 Express built by CUSTOM CAROLINA repeatedly highlight tournament-capable fittings and genuine on-water performance. Descriptions frequently note outfitting such as outriggers, a Bluewater battle station/fighting chair, and an expansive teak cockpit with mezzanine fish boxes. Twin Cummins QSM11 engines are commonly reported to cruise near 30 knots at roughly 65% load and to top out close to 38 knots when running on straight shafts. Owners and brokers credit the Carolina style hull penned by Steve French for its confident offshore motion, and many listings point to a Seakeeper 6 as a valuable addition for rolling reduction at anchor and during slow-speed maneuvers.

For owner-operators, the layout's single-cabin/one-head arrangement fits

weekend cruising well, supported by a Cummins Onan 7.5 kW generator and roughly 550 gallons of fuel for extended day trips. Brokers have noted at least one well-documented example maintained to near Bristol condition under a full-time captain, illustrating how professional management enhances these boats' appeal. On the maintenance side, QSM11s follow standard diesel servicing schedules; the Seakeeper 6 typically benefits from annual dealer service that owners budget a few thousand dollars for; the watermaker requires regular flushing and attention to filters and membranes; and owners have raised service and parts concerns with Eskimo ice chippers. With systems such as the Seakeeper, genset, Zipwake interceptors, bow thruster and Racor filtration onboard, expect to coordinate specialist technicians and plan ongoing maintenance accordingly.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Carolina style hull and Steve French design deliver a composed offshore ride per broker reports.
- Twin Cummins QSM11s reportedly cruise ~30 knots and reach ~38 knots on straight shafts.
- Serious fishing layout with outriggers, fighting chair, teak cockpit and mezzanine boxes, plus Seakeeper 6 for comfort.
- Single stateroom and one head limit multi family overnight capability.
- Gyro, genset, watermaker, ice chipper, Zipwake and bow thruster add complexity and specialist maintenance.
- Seakeeper requires periodic dealer service and Eskimo ice chippers have owner reported service and parts challenges.

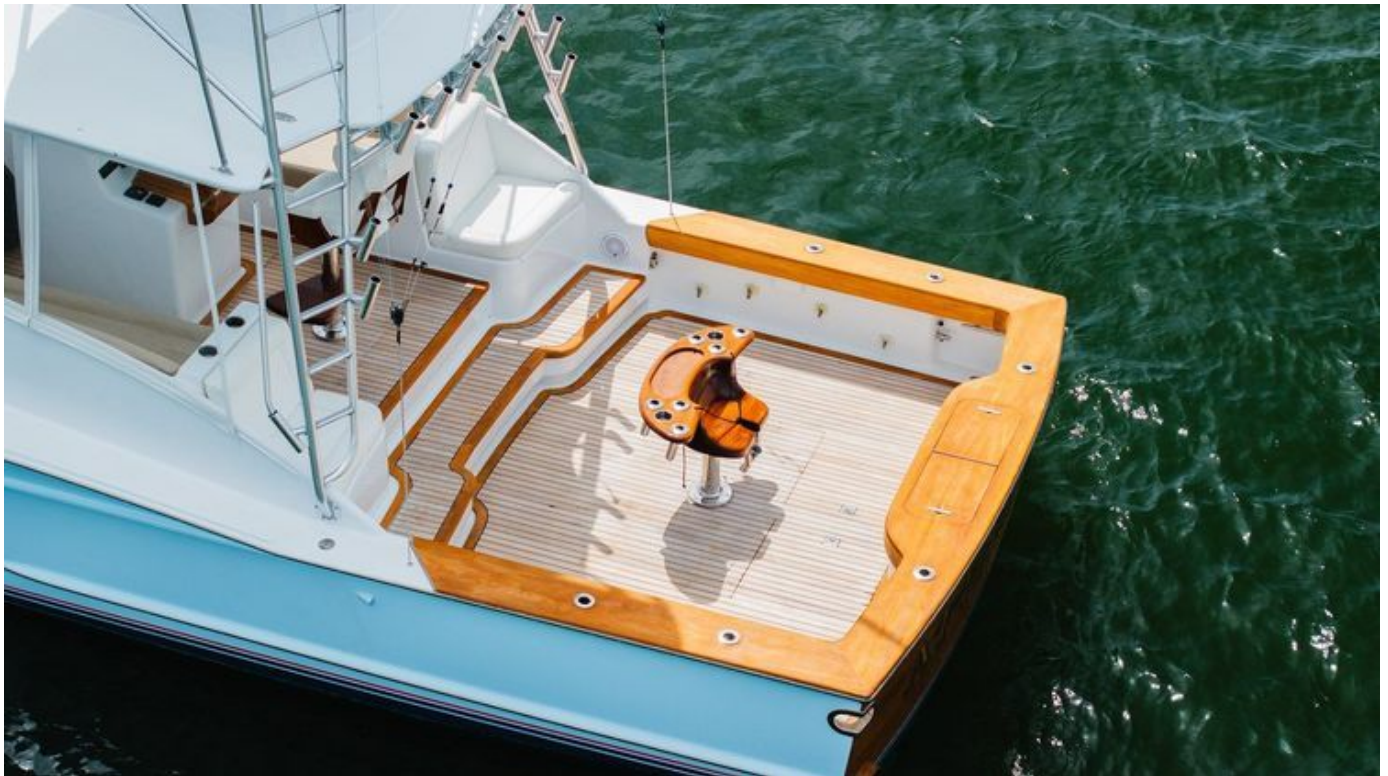
