OVERVIEW

Built by CUSTOM, the Diamante 23S is a compact, easy-care motor yacht configured as a practical pontoon design and built on an efficient aluminum hull. Measuring 23 ft LOA with an 8 ft beam, it's optimized for relaxed day cruising and straightforward ownership with minimal maintenance demands.

Selecting a Diamante 23S

If you prioritize uncomplicated handling, a stable entertaining deck, and a corrosion-resistant build, the Diamante 23S is a compelling choice. Its single Mercury outboard and aluminum construction deliver reliable, low-upkeep performance for casual outings. Coordinate directly with Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales to verify that this motor yacht featuring a pontoon layout meets your cruising expectations, slip requirements, and storage plans.

- Rugged construction: aluminum deck paired with an aluminum yacht hull for durability and easy care.
- Simple propulsion: a single Mercury outboard on gas keeps servicing straightforward while delivering practical day-boat speeds.
- Balanced performance: a cruising speed of 19 kn and a maximum of 21 kn support relaxed runs across lakes, rivers, and nearshore waters.
- Open, social layout typical of a pontoon platform, maximizing deck usability within the 23 ft footprint.

Q: What type of boat is the Diamante 23S? A: It's a motor yacht in the pontoon sub-category with an aluminum hull.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The **cruising speed** is 19 kn (21.86 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 21 kn (24.17 mph).

Q: What powers the boat? A: A single **Mercury outboard engine** running on **gas** .

Q: What are the size highlights? A: **LOA** is 23 ft (7.26 m) and **beam** is 8 ft (2.56 m).

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators commonly employ the Diamante 23S from CUSTOM for family day trips, watersports, light fishing, and short-term rentals; market listings show steady day-use demand and a layout that promotes easy movement on deck.

On the water, independent evaluations report responsive handling and economical performance. The triple pontoon configuration with lifting strakes and SeaStar hydraulic steering helps the hull hold flatter in turns while still delivering crisp cornering. Published figures for a 2023 Diamante 23S note roughly 19 kt at cruise and about 21 kt at wide open, and an independent trial of a related 23 model (23B) recorded an efficient cruise at 3,000 rpm covering 16.5 mph—consistent with the line’s reputation for easy running.

Comfort and onboard appointments are well-suited to day boating: a swingback stern lounge that converts from forward-facing bench to aft sunpad, woven-vinyl flooring, upscale seating, USB-C charging, and Rockford Fosgate audio; Boating Magazine also called out plush seating with dry storage and a clean minimalist interior. Ownership chores are generally simple with outboard packages from Mercury or Suzuki following routine service intervals, though the triple pontoon center tube and lifting strake hardware introduce a few additional inspection points (pontoons, strakes, trailer and launch fittings). Our review of public forums did not surface widespread owner complaints, though long-term open-source data is limited.

Pros and Cons

- Sharp handling and an efficient ride, with flatter turning aided by the triple toon hull and SeaStar hydraulic steering.
- Convertible swingback lounge and premium finishes (woven vinyl, USB C, Rockford Fosgate, dry storage seating) enhance day boat comfort.
- Versatile for family cruising, watersports, casual angling, and short term rentals.
- Published spec cites roughly 19 kt cruise and about 21 kt max, which may not satisfy speed focused buyers.
- Triple toon center tube and lifting strake hardware add inspection points for owners and trailer crews.
- Outboard propulsion (Mercury or Suzuki) requires routine service intervals and corrosion/anode checks.

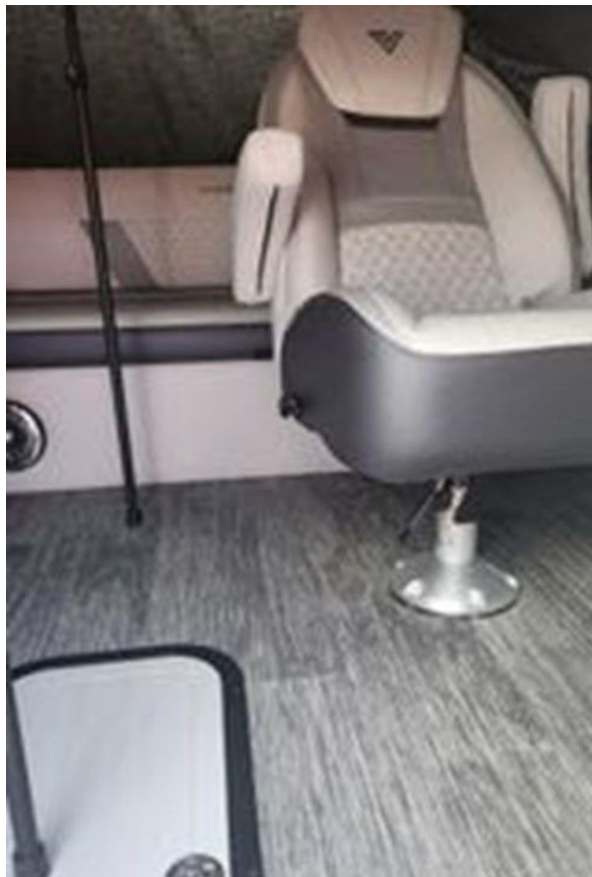
