Questions and Answers

Q: What are the speeds of the Fan Tail Motor Yacht? A: The yacht's **cruising speed** is 12 kn (13.81 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 13.5 kn (15.54 mph).

Q: How is the yacht classified? A: It's a motor yachts in the motor yacht class with a wooden hull type.

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Two **Caterpillar inboard diesel engines** provide dependable propulsion for consistent passagemaking.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA** is 96 ft (29.26 m), **beam** is 18 ft (5.64 m), and **max draft** is 28.15 ft (8.58 m).

Owner Experience Review

Across documented sisterships and boats sharing the name, the Fan Tail Motor Yacht by CUSTOM appears in roles ranging from family cruising to bluewater fishing and participation in classic-yacht events. Recorded examples include a West Bay SonShip "Fan Tail" promoted for family use with three guest cabins plus crew quarters, Hatteras 77 convertibles branded "Fan Tail" equipped for serious sportfishing, and the 1928 Custom "Blue Peter" used for cruising, charter duties, and committee/VIP service.

Reported seakeeping across these vessels stretches from comfortable semi-displacement cruising to true offshore capability. The West Bay version finds a compromise between interior volume and speed—reportedly cruising near 18 knots and reaching about 22 knots tops—while Hatteras 77 accounts highlight strong open-ocean handling and extended range, and the restored 1928 fantail "Blue Peter" is noted as steady and kindly at approximately a 12-knot cruise.

Comfort and finish comments differ by construction: the West Bay layout

offers an owner's suite plus double and twin cabins with teak decks and air conditioning; Hatteras 77 notes emphasize resilient, low-maintenance surfaces and large salon volumes; and "Blue Peter" preserves period-correct joinery with careful restoration work. Maintenance narratives reflect these variations—"Blue Peter" required a multi-year restoration exceeding \$4M and continues to need specialist wooden-yacht attention; some Hatteras 77 examples report complex multi-tank fuel systems with occasional gauge irregularities; and West Bay machinery such as twin Caterpillar 3412s benefits from well-established Caterpillar service networks and reputable refit yards. Details will change with specific refits and configurations, and direct owner reports for the Fan Tail Motor Yacht remain tied to these documented examples.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile documented roles: family cruising, bluewater sportfishing, and classic charter/regatta service.
- Generally sea kindly behavior, with semi displacement models cruising near 18 knots and up to about 22 knots, while classic builds are comfortable around 12 knots.
- Guest-oriented layouts and finish options range from three-suite family arrangements to meticulously restored period joinery.
- Traditional wooden examples require ongoing, specialized yard work despite extensive restorations.
- Some sportfishing variants employ complex multi-tank fuel systems that have had reported gauge problems.
- Certain designs can sacrifice salon headroom in favor of more accessible engine-room arrangements for servicing.
