OVERVIEW

The FL42 from CUSTOM measures 42.6 m (139 ft) and is presented as a purpose-built expedition yacht configured on a full-displacement platform with a steel hull. Listed by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, this design pairs rugged, commercial-grade construction with a comfortable 12.5-knot cruising pace and substantial internal volume of 489 gross tons.

Selecting a FL42

When offshore capability, interior space and long-range comfort are primary objectives, the FL42 is a compelling option. Powered by twin CAT diesel engines, it is intended to cruise efficiently at 12.5 knots with a top capability around 15 knots, and its full-displacement hull promotes a smoother ride on blue-water passages. Accommodating up to 14 people with dedicated crew quarters and shaped by Floating Life's design teams, it's engineered for extended voyages in the spirit of a contemporary expedition yacht.

Features of the Model

- Naval architecture by Floating Life - ZeroTredici Naval Designer; interiors by Floating Life - Satura Studio.
- Full-displacement construction with a steel hull and Steel decks for durability and stability.
- Twin CAT diesel power (2 engines) for reliable propulsion; cruise 12.5 kn (14.38 mph), max 15 kn (17.26 mph).
- Volume-forward layout with 489 gross tons, designed to support 14 accommodations, 9 sleeps, and 8 heads.
- Professional crew area with 5 crew cabins and 10 crew beds to maintain premium service standards underway.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the FL42? A: It is a **motor yacht** arranged as an **expedition yacht** built on a **steel hull** with a **full-displacement** hull form.

Q: What are the **speed** figures? A: The FL42 is specified to cruise at **12.5 kn (14.38 mph)** with a **maximum speed** of **15 kn (17.26 mph)** .

Q: How many people can it accommodate? A: The yacht provides **accommodations for 14** , with **9 sleeps** and **8 heads** ; the dedicated **crew** quarters include **5 cabins** housing **10 beds** .

Q: Who are the **designers** and the **builder** ? A: The vessel is built by CUSTOM, with hull design by Floating Life - ZeroTredici Naval Designer and interior design by Floating Life - Satura Studio.

Q: How much **fuel** and **fresh water** can it carry? A: Fuel capacity is **21,133.76 gal** and fresh water capacity is **3,170.06 gal** . For up-to-date availability, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Buyers considering the FL42 from CUSTOM will note the project's primary focus on long-range capability and seakeeping. Marketing materials portray it as an expedition, displacement platform with an approximate project range near 5,000 nautical miles, intended for true ocean crossings and prolonged itineraries rather than short coastal hops.

Onboard arrangements emphasized in press releases and broker decks lean toward privacy and guest comfort: a full beam owner's suite, four en suite guest staterooms (configured as two doubles and two twins), an expansive

main-deck salon and a substantial beach club serving the lower deck. Extensive outdoor living zones—wraparound promenades, a sundeck lounge and optional fold-out owner-suite balconies—underscore the “owner’s deck/owner’s condo” concept.

As a new or custom project listed for 2025, there is limited independent sea-trial data, long-term operating histories or comprehensive owner-handling feedback for the FL42. Published figures and commentary remain primarily spec- and press-driven. One recurring design detail mentioned is the “under lower deck” repositioned engine room to liberate guest volume, a choice that can affect maintenance access and service planning. Fractional and managed-ownership options have been promoted, though model-specific long-term operating costs and precise crew-sizing analyses are not yet widely documented.

Pros and Cons

- Projected ~5,000 nm range supports true ocean crossing, expedition itineraries.
- Flexible layouts with full beam owner suite, four en suite guest cabins, and a large beach club favor private family cruising and entertaining.
- Fractional/managed ownership pathways are available for shared usage and operational support.
- Independent sea trial reports and owner handling feedback for FL42 are currently scarce.
- Performance figures, including cruise and top speed, are not widely published for this model.
- The “under lower deck” engine room configuration may complicate service access and maintenance planning.

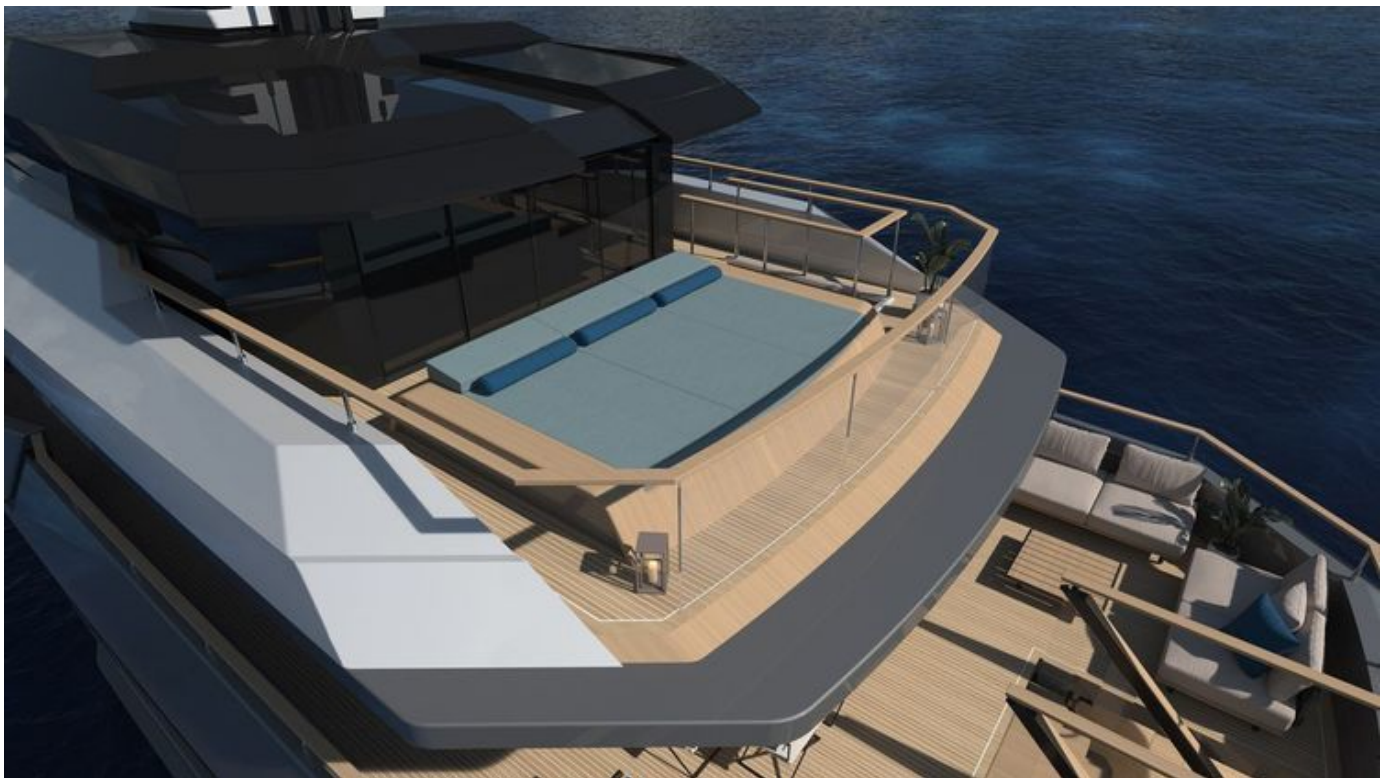
