OVERVIEW

Explore the GULET from CUSTOM — a yacht with distinct character designed as a flexible sail yacht and motorsailer hybrid, built on a durable wooden yacht hull. With an overall length of 114 ft (35 m), a 26 ft (7.9 m) beam and an 11.811 ft (3.6 m) draft, this monohull offers roomy interiors while maintaining composed cruising characteristics suited to extended stays at sea.

Opting for a GULET is sensible if you value the tactile warmth of a wooden yacht together with the practicality of twin inboard diesels and a steady 12 knot cruising pace. Designed to sleep up to 10 guests with dedicated crew accommodations, it is equally appropriate for private family voyages or hospitality-driven operations. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the GULET? A: It is a **sail yacht** arranged as a **motorsailer** built on a **wooden yacht** hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the GULET? A: The **LOA is 114 ft (35 m)** , with a **beam of 26 ft (7.9 m)** and a **max draft of 11.811 ft (3.6 m)** . The hull configuration is a **monohull** .

Q: What engines power the yacht and what is the cruising speed? A: The yacht is powered by **2 x Baudoin inboard diesel** engines and achieves a **cruising speed of 12 kn (13.81 mph)** .

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The layout accommodates **up to 10** guests with **5 heads** , plus **3 crew cabins** providing **6 berths** for crew members.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and operators commonly describe the CUSTOM GULET as first and foremost a hospitality-centric platform. Many are employed as crewed “Blue Cruise” charters along the Turkish coastline, frequently carrying around 8–16 guests, while private owners use similar arrangements for relaxed family cruising aboard 22–34 m vessels. Day-charter and event use is also widespread, underscoring a focus on social spaces and comfort rather than long ocean passages.

Underway, the CUSTOM GULET is not aimed at high-performance sailing; it favors unhurried passages and stable life on deck. The broad beam gives

reassuring steadiness and ample outdoor areas in sheltered coastal and Mediterranean conditions, but these designs are not intended for heavy-weather passagemaking. When motoring they maintain modest cruise speeds, and larger gulets are known to consume comparatively large amounts of fuel at working speeds.

Aboard, owners praise the roomy cabins—often with multiple en suite heads—and the traditional timber interiors that provide a warm, classic ambiance, though with increased maintenance demands. Wooden and custom builds require regular varnishing, routine annual inspections, and occasional refits; many purchasers plan for an initial season of upgrades after purchase. Owners' forums also note that charter-spec rigging and sails may need more frequent replacement, engine-room access can be tight on several layouts, and proactive upkeep is important to manage common A/C, plumbing, and engine items. As with any custom yacht, outcomes vary significantly by yard, age, and service history.

Pros and Cons

- Spacious guest layout with multiple en suite cabins is well suited to week long charters and family vacations accommodating 8–16 guests.
- Wide beam, stable platform offers comfortable coastal Mediterranean cruising and is ideal for day events.
- Traditional wood interiors and extensive social decks foster a relaxed, welcoming onboard environment.
- Not designed for performance sailing and not optimized for heavy weather passagemaking.
- Wooden/custom construction demands frequent varnish work and periodic refits; some charter rigging and sails may require regular renewal.
- Larger gulets tend to consume substantial fuel at working speeds compared with lighter cruising yachts.

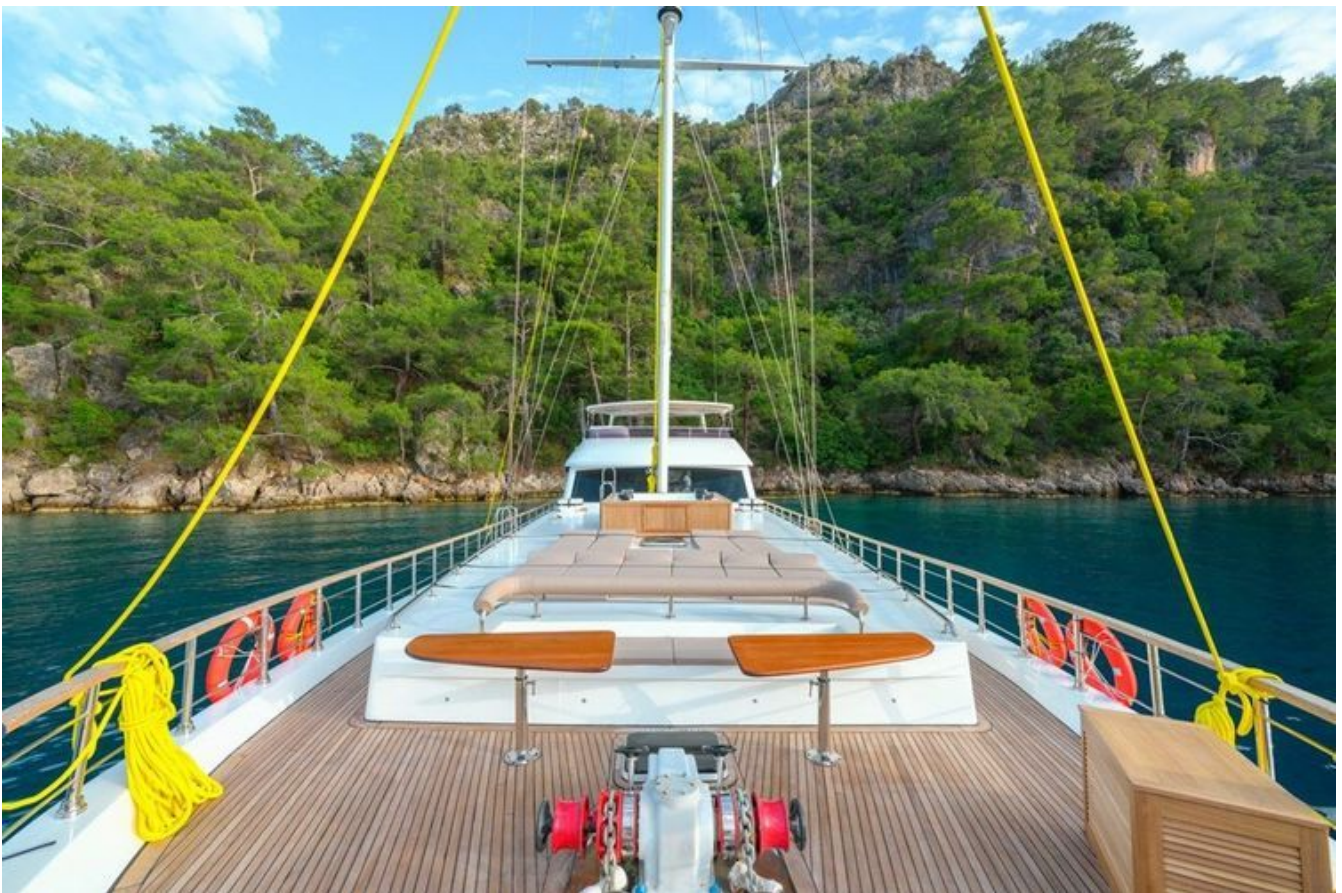
