## OVERVIEW

---

The Hunt Express Weekender from CUSTOM is a 26-foot motor yacht created for leisurely weekend escapes. Its 8-foot beam and catamaran layout, combined with a lightweight construction in fiberglass and plastic, deliver a blend of stability, efficiency, and pace ideal for coastal cruising and short day trips. Shestakov Yacht Sales, represented by broker Andrey Shestakov, is available to assist with inspections, viewings, and the purchase process.

If your priority is a compact, easy-to-handle cruiser that covers ground efficiently and handles coastal conditions with confidence, the Hunt Express Weekender is a strong contender. The catamaran hull enhances directional stability and predictable handling, while the single Yamaha gas powerplant keeps operation and maintenance straightforward.

With a 90-gallon fuel tank and a 28-gallon freshwater system, this model is geared toward day outings and short weekend voyages. Its composite deck and fiberglass and plastic hull construction emphasize durability and minimize upkeep for owners.

- Catamaran hull that promotes steady tracking and balanced handling in a variety of sea states.
- Built in fiberglass and plastic with a composite deck to offer longevity and reduced maintenance demands.
- Single Yamaha gasoline engine that simplifies ownership and routine servicing.

- Performance-minded: approximately 25 knots cruising speed (28.77 mph) with a top end near 40 knots (46.03 mph).
- Practical tankage for short excursions: 90 gallons of fuel and 28 gallons of freshwater.

- Designed as a nimble cruiser within the motor yacht category.

Q: What type of yacht is the Hunt Express Weekender? A: It is a compact motor yacht configured as a versatile cruiser, constructed in fiberglass and plastic and featuring a catamaran hull to provide balanced handling. **Type** and **hull configuration** are optimized for confident day trips and weekend outings.

Q: What are the performance figures? A: The vessel maintains a **cruising speed** of 25 kn (28.77 mph) and can reach a **maximum speed** of 40 kn (46.03 mph) powered by a single Yamaha **engine** running on **gas** .

Q: How much fuel and water does it carry? A: The **fuel capacity** is 90 gallons and the **water capacity** is 28 gallons, which supports typical day trips and short **weekend cruising** itineraries.

Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: **LOA** measures 26 ft (7.92 m), **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m), and **draft** is 4.373 ft (1.333 m), making it suitable for a range of coastal operations where depth allows.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and prospective buyers generally regard the Hunt Express Weekender by CUSTOM as an ideal dayboat or weekend cruiser for small family outings. Brokerage descriptions consistently list a 26-foot LOA, an approximate cruise speed of 25 knots, and a reported top speed near 40 knots, positioning the design for brisk coastal hops and energetic day runs.

Expect modest onboard living amenities: several listings either omit cabin

details or explicitly indicate "Cabins: N/A," suggesting limited overnight facilities. Publicly available owner feedback is limited; we found no forum threads or independent reviews covering sea-keeping, wave handling, detailed maneuvering characteristics, engine-room access, common maintenance issues, or typical service expenses, leaving these operational aspects largely undocumented online.

## Pros and Cons

- Well matched to weekend and dayboat leisure use and short family cruises, according to brokerage listings for the Hunt Express Weekender.
- Advertised cruise speed of roughly 25 knots enables efficient coastal runs and day trips.
- Multiple listings report a top speed around 40 knots for rapid passages.
- Overnight sleeping arrangements appear minimal, with several listings showing no cabin details or "Cabins: N/A".
- No independent owner accounts located on sea-keeping, wave response, or in-depth handling notes.
- Public resources do not document engine-room accessibility, frequent repairs, or anticipated service costs.
