OVERVIEW

The 86 ft motor yacht Motoryacht from DITMAR DONALDSON combines traditional wooden craftsmanship with twin Caterpillar inboard diesel powerplants. At 26.36 m LOA, with a 22 ft beam and an 18.045 ft draft, this mega yacht is laid out with six heads, two crew cabins, and large tankage—3,750 gal fuel and 1,500 gal water. Owner Experience Review

Owners' comments and broker summaries portray the Motoryacht by DITMAR DONALDSON as a traditional, heavy-displacement wooden cruiser with assured handling and dependable performance. Multiple listings credit its steady, predictable behavior to twin Caterpillar D343 diesels (about 1,100 hp total), positioning the yacht as a comfortable passage-making platform rather than a fast-planing vessel.

Inside, the arrangement favors family use and entertaining: reports commonly list five guest cabins accommodating up to ten guests, alongside full crew quarters comprising two cabins and a dedicated work station. Brokers emphasize a very large salon and dining area, plus an updated galley featuring new woodwork and premium appliances, making the yacht well suited for classic-motor-yacht leisure and hosting events. There are occasional notes of sport-fishing use, and historical press references mention that Sapphire Sea II was used by Bob Hope for fishing excursions.

Maintenance realities reflect classic wooden-yacht ownership: regular

varnishing, deck and joinery upkeep, and intermittent comprehensive refits. Some sale records cite more than \$1,000,000 spent on refit work in the last decade, and reported engine hours for D343 installations are around the mid-7,000s; prospective buyers should confirm specifics for any individual hull. Model-specific public owner forum discussion is limited, so most insights derive from broker specifications and listing documentation rather than extended owner logs.

Pros and Cons

- Heavy-displacement ride and confident handling foster comfortable cruising.
- Spacious interior with huge salon, dining, and an updated galley suits entertaining.
- Five-cabin layout with crew quarters supports private family cruising for up to ten guests.
- Not a high-speed boat compared with modern motor yachts.
- Wooden hull and superstructure demand ongoing varnish, deck, and joinery maintenance plus periodic refits.
- Documentation relies heavily on broker/spec listings, with few sustained model-specific owner reports.

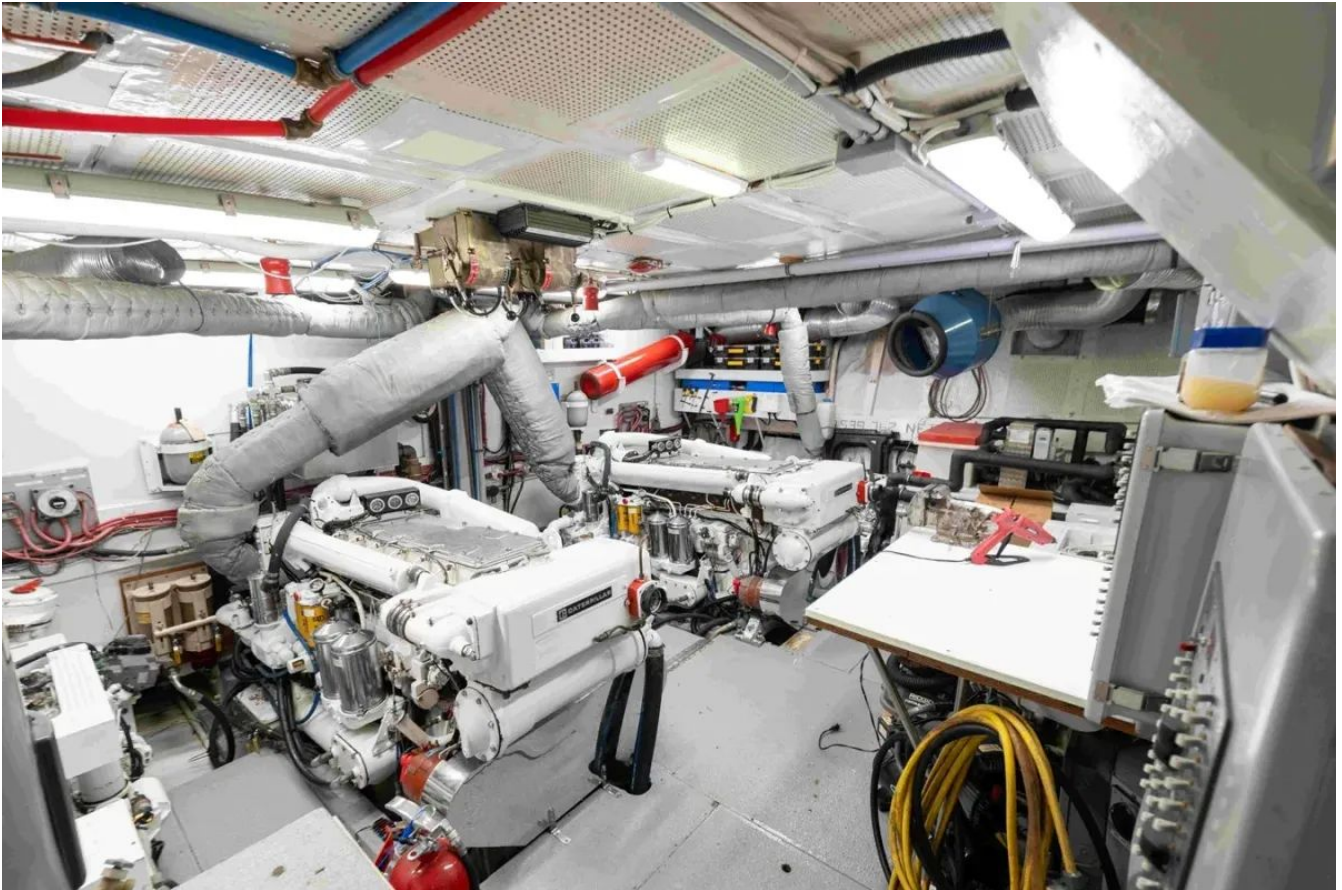
