## OVERVIEW

---

The 2021 from DUSKY brings the utility of a motor yacht within the broader motor yachts category into a compact 25 foot package. It is driven by a single Evinrude gas/petrol outboard, set on a sturdy fiberglass hull with a matching fiberglass deck, and carries 100 gallons of fuel to support confident, full day cruising and extended runs.

## Selecting a 2021

---

If your priorities include the simplicity and lower operating cost of a single engine arrangement, easy handling in a modest 25 ft footprint, and the efficiency of a light, well designed dayboat, the 2021 is worth considering. - Constructed by DUSKY as a motor yacht within the motor yachts class
- A practical 25 ft (7.62 m) LOA with an 8 ft (2.56 m) beam that simplifies docking and trailering
- Single Evinrude propulsion system, designed for **gas/petrol** operation
- Durable fiberglass hull paired with a fiberglass deck for longevity
- 100 gallon onboard fuel reserve to support full day excursions and longer hops

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the dimensions of the DUSKY 2021? A: The vessel's **LOA** measures 25 ft (7.62 m) and the **beam** measures 8 ft (2.56 m).

Q: What powers this model? A: Propulsion comes from a single **Evinrude** engine running on **gas/petrol** .

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The **hull** is constructed of fiberglass, and the **deck** is fiberglass as well.

Q: How much fuel does it carry? A: **Fuel capacity** is 100 gallons.

Q: Who can help me purchase and survey the boat? A: **Andrey Shestakov** and the team at **Shestakov Yacht Sales** will assist with selection, inspections, viewings, and the closing process for this motor yacht in the motor yachts category.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners who choose the 2021 from DUSKY most often use it for serious angling—ranging from inshore trips to offshore tournament work—while also bringing along family for weekend cruising. Reports commonly highlight the generous freeboard and the spacious cockpit that make both day fishing and family outings comfortable, with layouts and fittings oriented toward rugged use rather than high end finishes. Several owners have even completed roughly 200 mile runs, such as Bahamas hops, on 25 foot Dusky boats when suitably outfitted and carefully planned.

On the water, owner feedback praises a dry, steady ride through chop and following seas, with many crediting the Dusky Drive bracket for improved handling and reduced transom green water. Typical comments note smooth cruising in the 25–30 knot range and top speeds of 45–50 knots when lightly loaded. Caveats are mentioned: some narrow beam configurations can feel marginal for serious Gulf Stream conditions, and numerous owners recommend twin engines on vessels 25' and larger for redundancy and quicker planing. Maintenance experiences vary—forums frequently reference gelcoat or stress cracking where the Dusky Drive meets the transom and warn that factory direct sales can complicate warranty or service work—yet long term owners also report many years of heavy use without hull or drive failures.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Smooth, dry ride in chop and following seas.
- Roomy cockpit and high freeboard make it well suited to serious fishing and family day outings.
- Documented longer passages (e.g., ~200 miles on 25' DUSKY) when the boat is properly prepared and voyaging is planned.
- Repeated reports of gelcoat/stress cracks at the Dusky Drive/transom interface.
- Factory direct sales model can complicate warranty coverage and service access.
- Narrower beam variants may feel undersized for heavy offshore conditions; twin engines are commonly recommended on 25'+ boats for redundancy.
