OVERVIEW

Discover the DA 53 by DUTCH AMERICAN — a motor yacht in the motor yachts class, built on an aluminum hull. Listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this 53-foot design combines four Mercury outboards, durable aluminum construction, and a fuel capacity suited to extended cruising.

If your brief calls for a 53-foot yacht that keeps systems straightforward with four Mercury outboards, benefits from the toughness of an aluminum hull, and occupies a 15-foot beam, the DA 53 is a practical candidate. Positioned within the broader motor yachts segment, this motor yacht delivers usable dimensions and specification choices that appeal to owner-operators and private cruisers. Owner Experience Review

Initial feedback on the DA 53 from DUTCH AMERICAN emphasizes its adaptability for family overnights and social weekend trips. The layout includes two cabins with a full beam mid ship master, a salon featuring a retractable glass roof and U shaped seating that converts via a hi/lo table to an additional berth, plus a full galley and climate control—features that support comfortable coastal cruising.

On the water, reviewers note a hull that cuts through chop, offers smooth glide, and maintains stability. With quad Mercury Verado 600s (2,400 hp), the boat shows brisk acceleration; Boating World recorded an approximate 48 knot top speed, while dealer video and marketing clips have suggested speeds near 56 mph. The inclusion of a Seakeeper 6 and a V hull with a

pronounced flared bow and tumblehome stern are repeatedly mentioned for their contribution to reduced roll and an improved ride.

Because the DA 53 is a recent offering (public listings indicate production beginning in 2024), long term owner feedback is limited. Buyers should plan for routine servicing of four V12 outboards in addition to specialist maintenance for the Seakeeper gyro and the Northern Lights generator. Layouts and system access shown in listings suggest simple service points—outboards on the transom and house systems in the lazarette—and to date there are no widely reported systemic faults in public sources.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile layout suited to family cruising and entertaining, featuring two cabins, a convertible salon, and climate control.
- Deck arrangements designed for socializing: bow and aft sun pads, dual hi/lo cockpit tables, integrated audio system, and a hydraulic swim platform.
- Confident on water performance and ride; quad Verado 600s provide strong speeds and the Seakeeper 6 plus hull form mitigate roll.
- Limited independent long term ownership data available due to the model's recent 2024 introduction.
- Anticipate higher maintenance scope and expense with four V12 outboards, a Seakeeper gyro, and a generator that require specialist servicing.
- Single head (often arranged as a split shower/head) may feel constrained for two cabins during extended cruises.

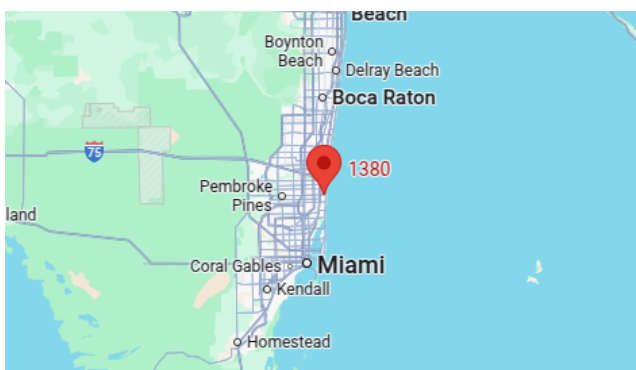
