## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and listings for the Illusion 3200 commonly describe ENVISION's Illusion as a sensible family cruiser aimed at weekend escapes—local hops,

poker runs, and lake outings—yet it retains a performance-oriented character for a 32-foot craft. The enclosed head and comfortable cabin layout are frequent highlights, providing practical accommodations for children and short family vacations. Depending on the specific example, layouts range from closed-bow or mid-cuddy arrangements to open-bow configurations, and many boats include familiar features such as bolster helm seating, wrap-around aft benches, and an extended swim platform.

On the water, owners report rapid transitions onto plane and a steady, composed ride, with consistent compliments for its V-hull manners in chop and heavier conditions. Typical cruising speeds around 38 mph are often cited, though top-end performance will vary with engine output and onboard weight. Some twin-engine variants have shown sensitivity in listing or trim until trim tabs and prop/drive configurations are properly adjusted. Maintenance notes emphasize a solid, non-cored fiberglass hull that reduces concerns associated with cored laminate intrusion, but standard pre-purchase checks remain important: inspect stringers and the transom and open service panels. Practical details include systems like the freshwater pump being mounted behind panels or in the bilge, so surveys frequently require accessing hatches and probing under covers.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Very quick to plane with a smooth, stable on-water ride reported by owners.
- Regularly commended for handling rough water well due to a solid V-hull character.
- Solid, non-cored fiberglass hull lessens typical water-intrusion concerns associated with cored construction.
- Some twin-engine versions exhibit listing or trim sensitivity until tabs and prop/drive setups are optimized.
- Components such as the freshwater pump may be concealed behind panels,

making them time-consuming to locate and service.

- Top speed is dependent on engine selection and vessel weight, so performance differs between individual boats.

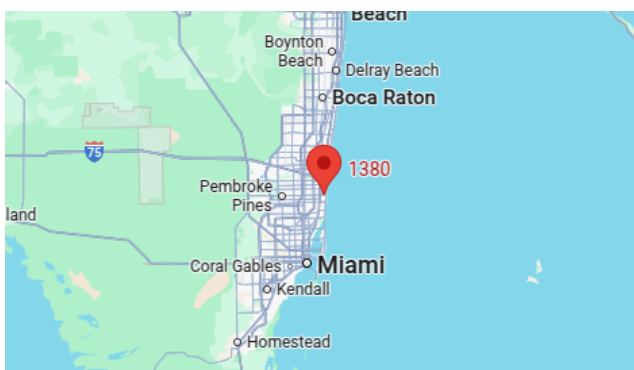
